CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION TRAINING

OBJECTIVE:

- To equip students and community members with essential life-saving skills through CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) training.
- To raise awareness about the importance of timely first aid in emergency situations.
- To promote a sense of responsibility among youth to act swiftly and effectively during medical emergencies.

DETAILS:

The CPR Training Workshop was organized by the NCC cadets of Arka Jain University on 21st March 2025. This initiative was aimed at empowering young citizens with the ability to save lives through quick and effective CPR techniques.

A total of 38 NCC cadets participated in the training session, comprising 30 Senior Division (SD) and 08 Senior Wing (SW) cadets, along with university faculty members and local students.

Activities:

- The session began with expert demonstrations by certified CPR instructors, including trained paramedics and senior NCC officers.
- Detailed guidance was provided on the steps of administering CPR, including chest compressions and rescue breathing techniques.
- Participants were educated on recognizing cardiac arrest symptoms and the importance of immediate action.
- Practical hands-on training was conducted using CPR manikins, allowing each cadet to practice the techniques under expert supervision.
- Demonstrations also included the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) and handling choking emergencies.

Interactive Session:







An open Q&A session was held where students clarified their doubts and shared scenarios where CPR could be critical.

Participants were encouraged to discuss how they can spread awareness and teach CPR basics within their communities.

Cadets took a pledge to remain prepared to assist in medical emergencies and promote the importance of first aid knowledge.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

- The training successfully enhanced the cadets' confidence and competence in administering CPR during emergencies.
- Participants demonstrated high enthusiasm, active participation, and a willingness to further educate others on life-saving skills.
- The program cultivated a proactive approach towards community health and emergency preparedness among the youth.
- This initiative reinforced Arka Jain University's commitment to nurturing responsible, skilled, and compassionate citizens.




Fig. 2- During Training




Fig. 4- Expert is giving demo
