NATIONAL PHARMACY EDUCATION DAY 2025

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of A Day for Birds – IV 2025 was to commemorate World Sparrow Day (20th March) and celebrate Jan Jatiya Gourav Varsh on 12th April 2025, by addressing crosscutting issues related to the environment and sustainability. The event aimed to raise awareness about the role of birds in ecological balance and environmental conservation while fostering a spirit of compassion and responsibility among students and faculty members.

DETAILS:

On 12th April 2025, Bhesajam the Pharma Club of the School of Pharmacy organized an event named A Day for Birds - IV at the University campus commemorating World Sparrow Day and observing Jan Jatiya Gourav Varsh to address the crosscutting issue and meeting the local as well as global needs.
