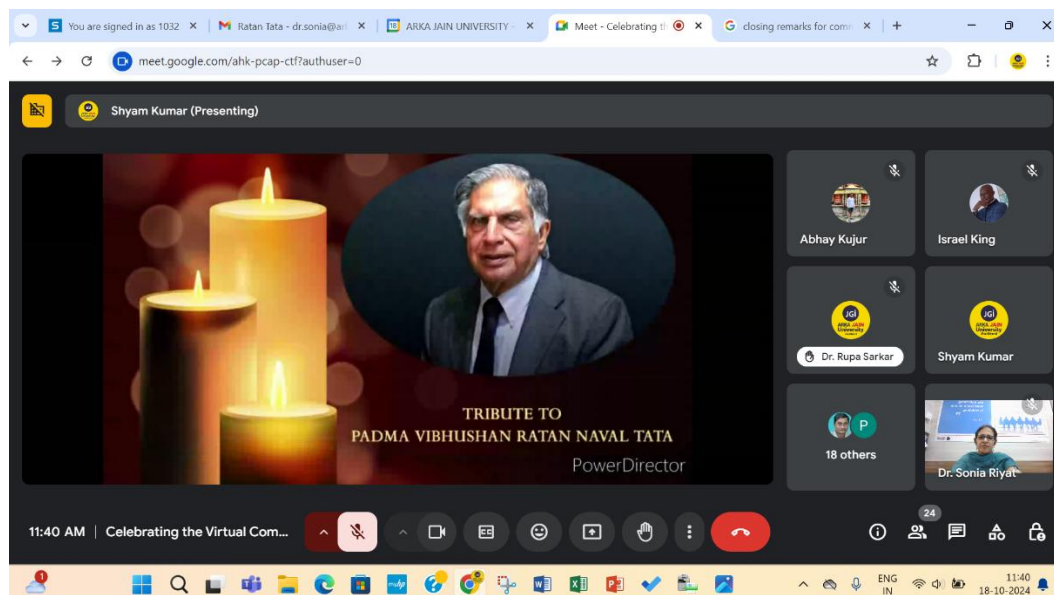


**Fig 1: SCREENSHOT VIRTUAL COMMEMORATION OF SRI RATAN TATA**

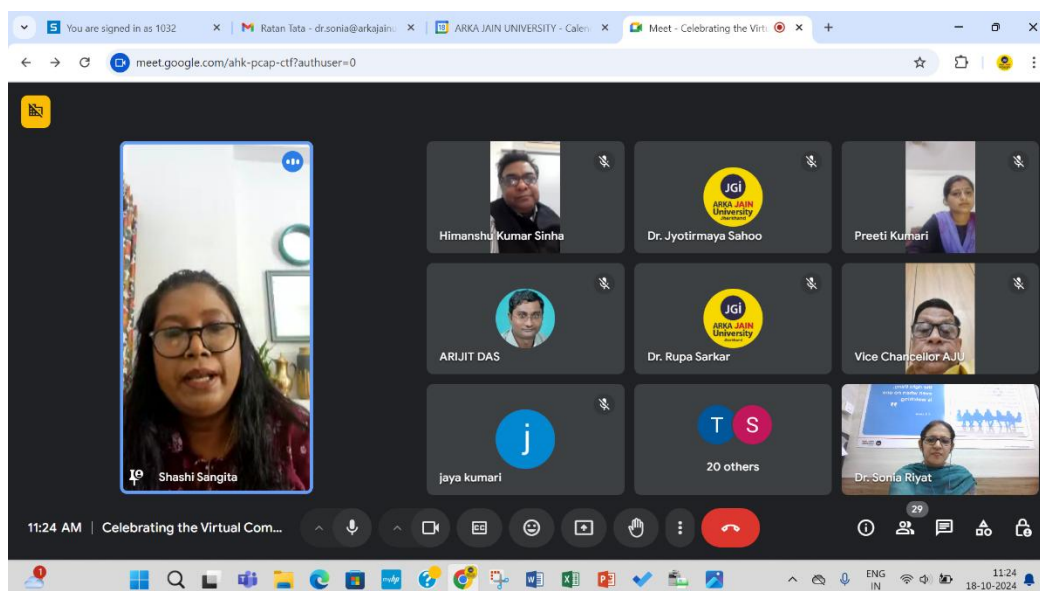


**Fig 2: SCREENSHOT VIRTUAL COMMEMORATION OF SRI RATAN TATA**
