Educational Trip to Centre for Excellence and Geological Park


Dear Students,

The Department of English, organised an Educational Trip to Centre for Excellence and Geological Park, Jamshedpur on 24th October, 2024 at 9.30 a.m.

Details:

The B.A. English (H) students of ARKA JAIN University embarked on an educational trip on 24 October 2024, visiting the Centre for Excellence and the Geological Park in Jamshedpur. The excursion provided an enriching experience outside the classroom, allowing students to explore the intersections of literature, history, and geology in a real-world context.

The visit to the Centre for Excellence offered insights into regional development and industrial achievements, showcasing exhibits on Jamshedpur's growth, culture, and Tata Steel's historical contributions. This experience aimed to broaden students' understanding of societal narratives, relevant for their literature studies, as they could analyze real-life representations of progress and community identity.

At the Geological Park, students observed a variety of rock formations, minerals, and fossils, helping them appreciate natural history and earth sciences. This exploration highlighted the significance of geology in literature, symbolizing aspects of permanence, change, and the passage of time – recurring themes in many literary works. The trip was designed to enhance students' analytical skills by exposing them to various cultural and scientific contexts, linking their academic studies with practical, interdisciplinary learning.

Taameir Shahid, Manager Communication, Tata Steel Limited, was there at CFE and Geological Park to describe the journey of the Tata Family, its industrial development and the contributions of Mr. P. N. Bose in the field of Geological survey and establishment of Tata Steel in Jamshedpur. It offered students a real-world experience that complements their curriculum, helping them see literature through interdisciplinary lenses. It also fostered



appreciation for local history, industry, and geological formations, creating a contextual framework. The students got encouraged for critical thinking by being exposed to exhibit geological samples, and the storytelling aspects of history and natural sciences.




Fig. 1 Mr. Taameir Shahid, Manager Communication, Tata Steel, briefing the students at the entrance of Centre for Excellence (CFE)
