WORLD MALARIA DAY: AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

The NSS units of ARKA JAIN University observed World Malaria Day with the village-folk of Musrikudar on 24th April, 2024 to provide "education and understanding of malaria" and spread information on "year-long intensified implementation of national malaria-control strategies, including community-based activities for malaria prevention and treatment in endemic areas.

DETAILS:

The NSS units of ARKA JAIN University observed World Malaria prevention Day on 25/04/2024 in association with School of Nursing NSS Student volunteers at Musari kudar village at 10.00 am. The programme commenced with students educating the community people about the disease, its definition, causes, sign and symptoms and preventive measures. Village people were encouraged to participate in quiz session by the volunteers.

Prof. Ginu Joseph and Ms. Pinki Dey of the School of Nursing communicated preventive measurs of malaria maong the villagers to make them aware of malaria prevention and cure. Prof. Ginu said that one should apply mosquito repellent with DEET (diethyltoluamide) to exposed skin. There should be draping of mosquito netting over beds.

Ms. Pinki Dey, Nursing Tutor and NSS Program Officer suggested to put screens on windows and doors. She firther suggested to treat clothing, mosquito nets, tents, sleeping bags and other fabrics with an insect repellent called permethrin.

The villagers who could reply well after the sessions on malaria protection measures were rewarded with mosquito net. The programme ended with the distribution of small packets of biscuit. The volunteers displayed some art charts also to make the villagers aware of malaria, its causes, and protection measures.

NSS Program Officer Dr. Manoj K Pathak in his vote of thanks encouraged the villagers to keep themselves aware of malaria protection measures and practice accordingly.
