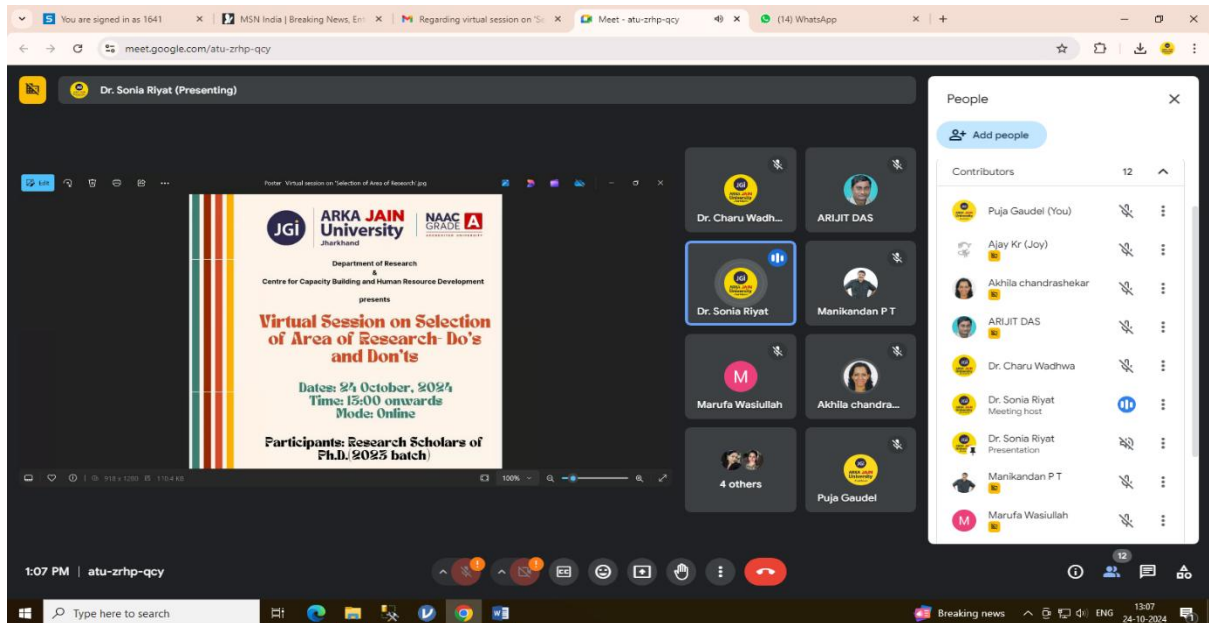


Fig 1. VIRTUAL SESSION ON SELECTION OF AREA OF RESEARCH- DOS & DON'TS

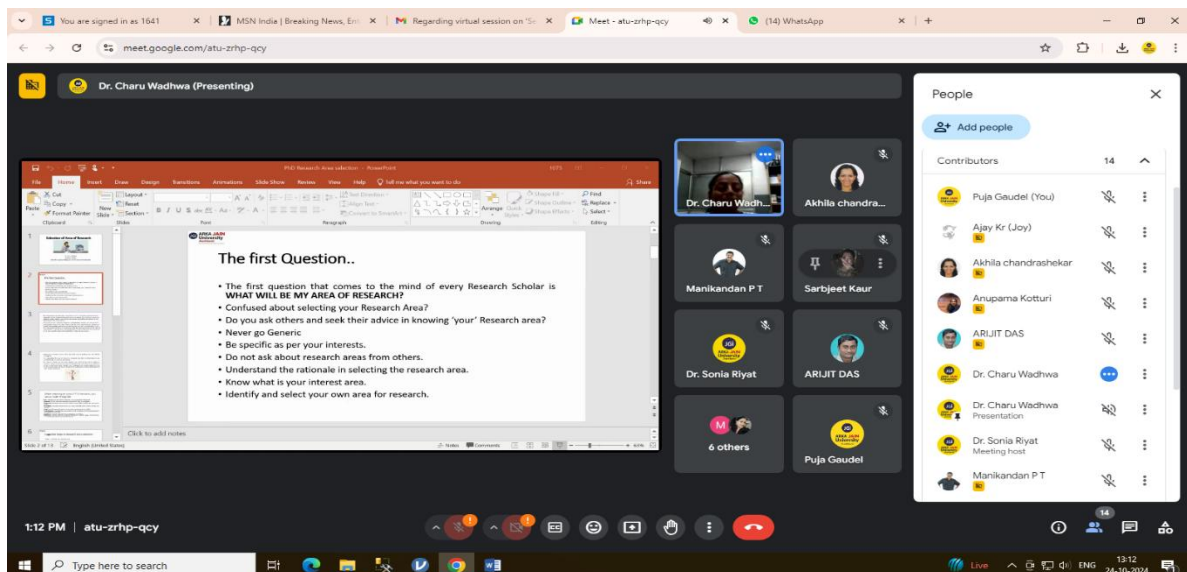
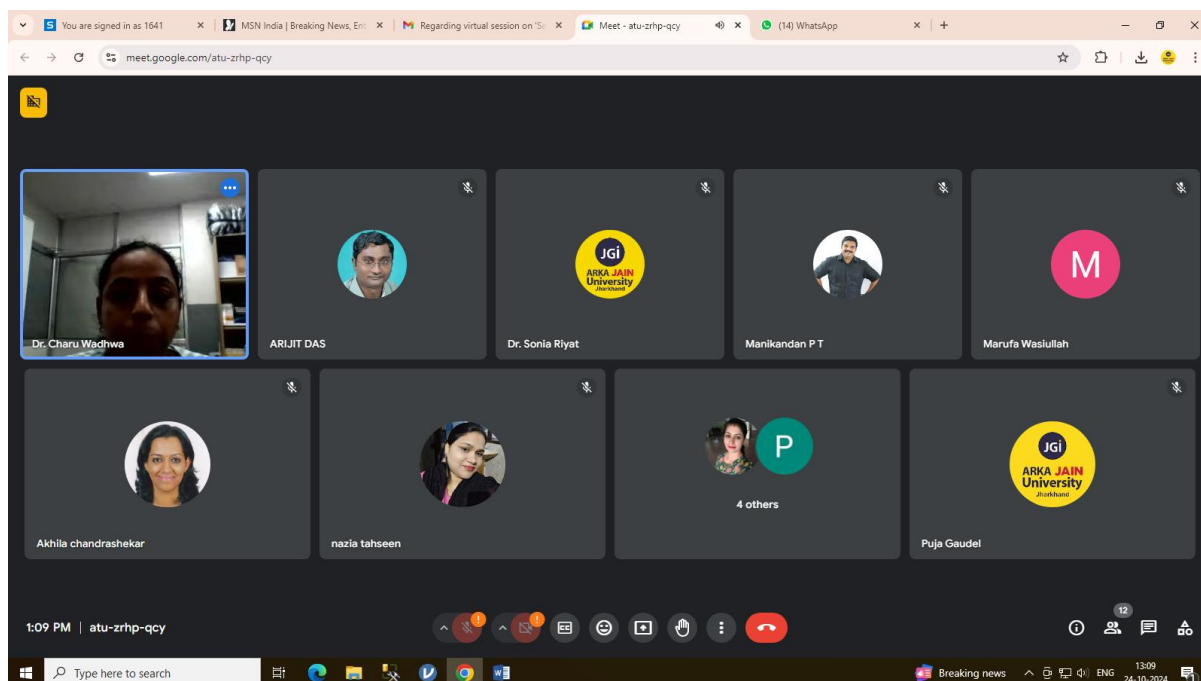
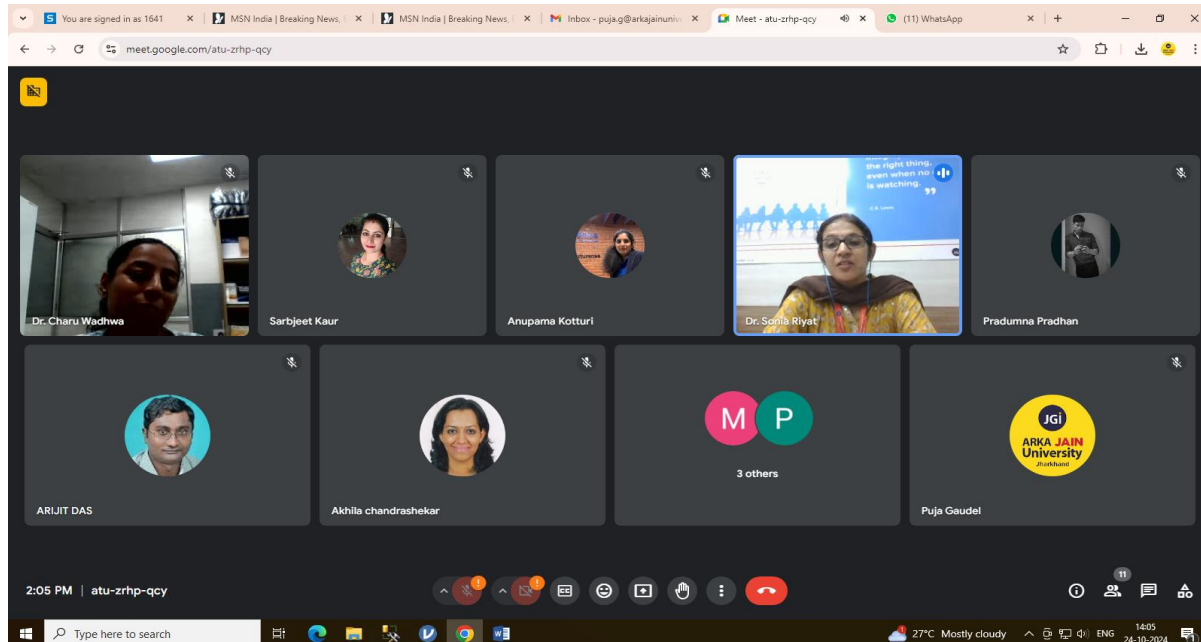


Fig 2 VIRTUAL SESSION ON SELECTION OF AREA OF RESEARCH- DOS & DON'TS

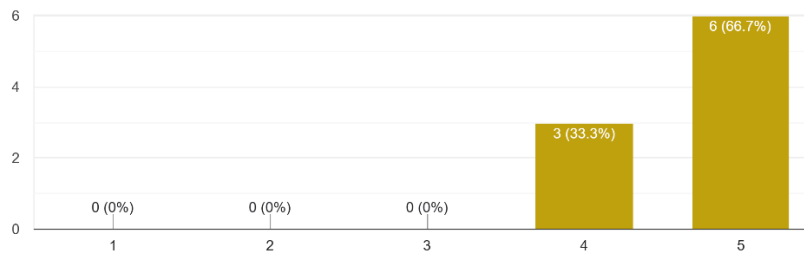

At the end of the session, feedback form was shared with all the participants. A total of 9 participants have filled up the feedback form within the prescribed timeline.

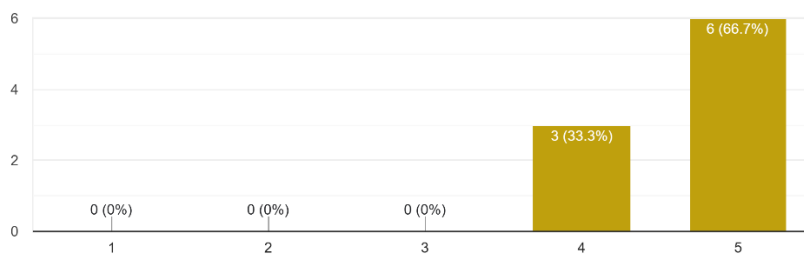
The virtual session's objectives were stated clearly and met.

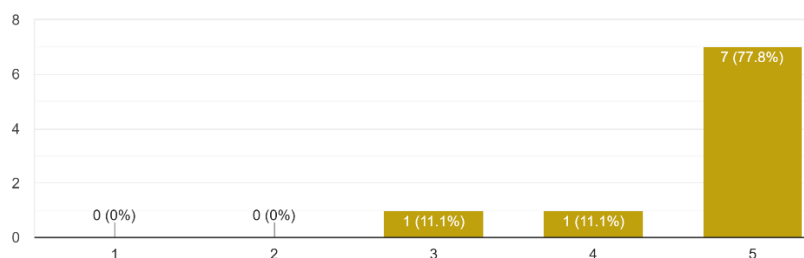
This virtual session was well organised.

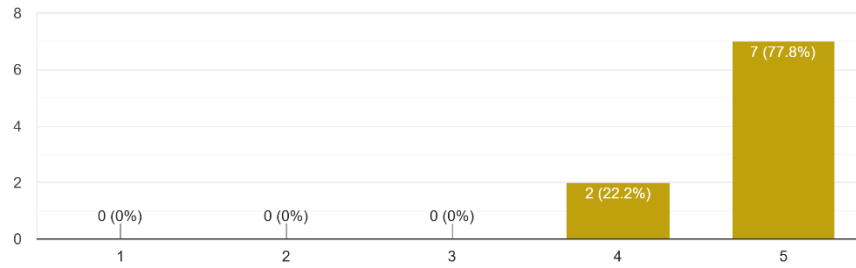
