#### **OBJECTIVE:**

By interacting with a seasoned entrepreneur and counsellor, the session aimed to help students develop essential qualities like resilience, confidence, communication, and strategic thinking, which are critical for entrepreneurial success.

#### **DETAILS:**

The much-anticipated IdeaX 3.0 event was held on 28th January 2025, starting at 10:00 AM, in the Block A Auditorium of ARKA JAIN University.
