**OBJECTIVE:** The primary objective of SAMVAAD, the Parents-Teacher Meeting organized by the School of Commerce and Management (SCOM), ARKA JAIN University, was to establish a strong communication bridge between faculty and parents, ensuring mutual collaboration for the academic and personal development of students. The session aimed to provide a transparent forum to discuss academic progress, student behavior, classroom engagement, and career preparedness.

**DETAILS:** SAMVAAD, meaning “dialogue,” was thoughtfully designed to facilitate open and constructive communication between faculty members and parents/guardians of students from BBA Sec-F, Semester II, under SCOM, virtually, over Google Meet.

Class In charge shared student performance reports, updates on attendance, participation in co-curricular activities, and notable behavioral observations. The session also offered parents a clear understanding of the University’s academic roadmap, internship opportunities, examination policies, and support systems available for student welfare.

Special emphasis was laid on discussing how parents and teachers can collaborate to guide students not only academically, but also in terms of discipline, time management, mental wellness, and career orientation of their wards. 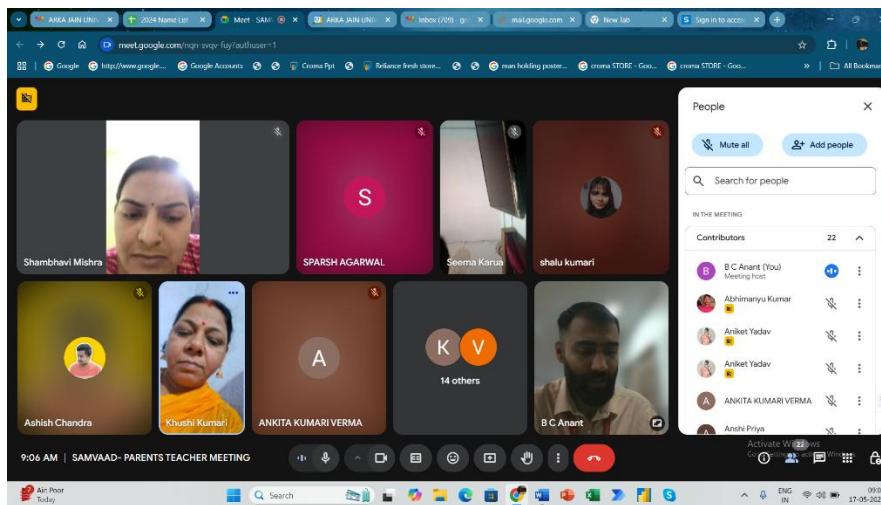

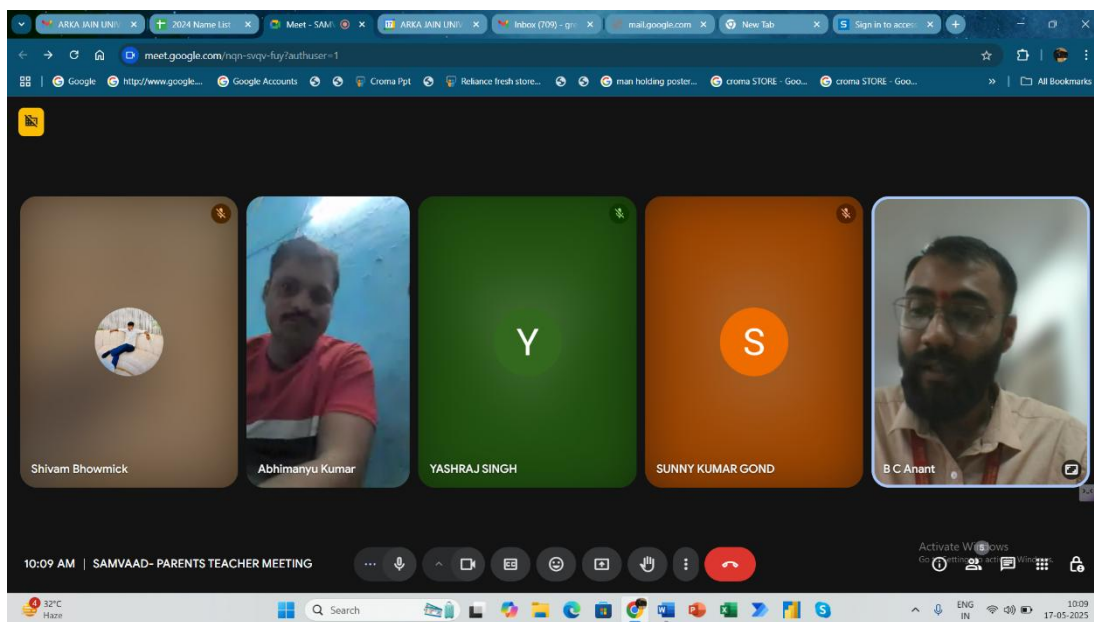

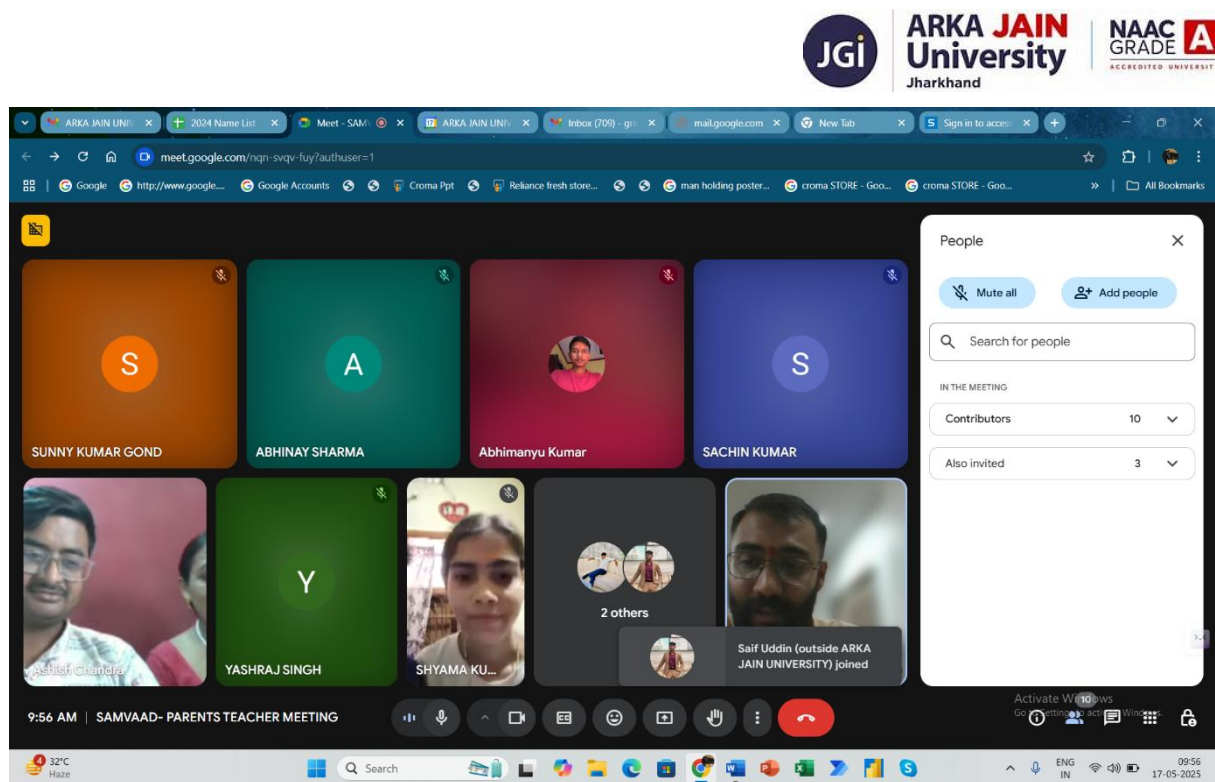


**Fig.1 Parents being addressed by the class in charge about SAMVAAD**

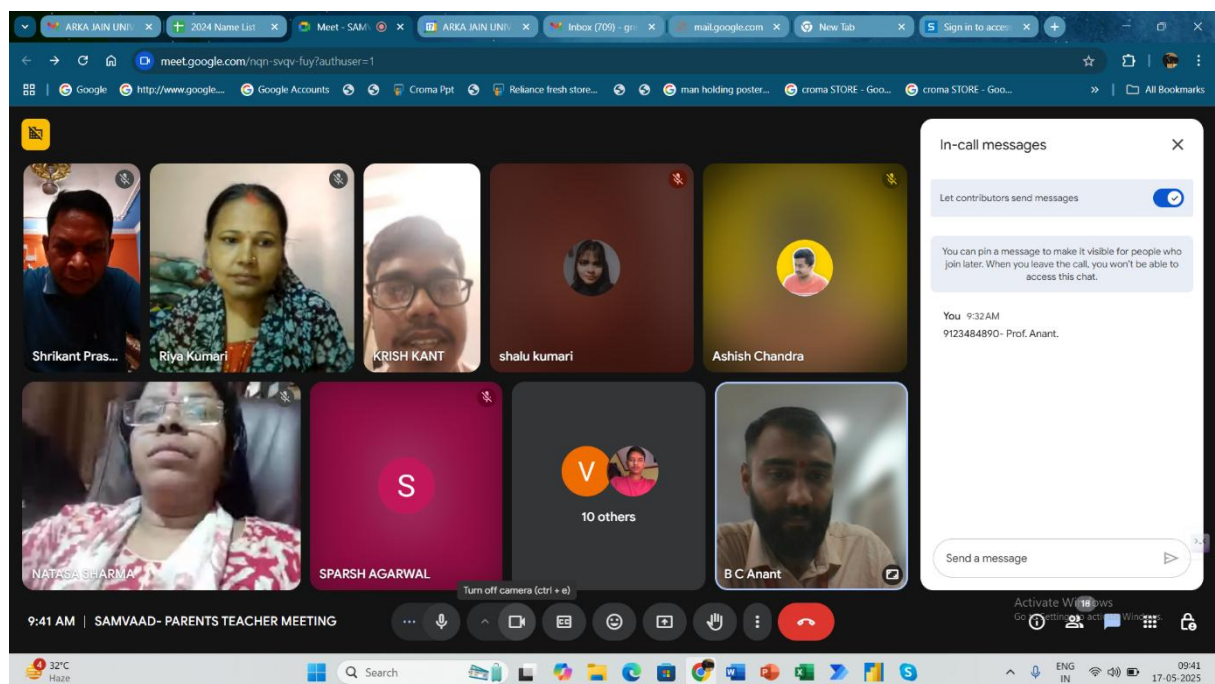


**Fig.2 Rally Parent discussing progress of their ward**
