OBJECTIVE:

The primary objective of the Quiz Competition was to commemorate **Independence Day – Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav** by engaging students in an interactive and educational activity that deepened their knowledge of India's Constitution and the nation's struggle for freedom. The event sought to rekindle the spirit of patriotism among students, promote awareness and understanding of India's constitutional values and democratic principles, and encourage active participation through a competitive yet educational format. It also aimed to foster teamwork, critical thinking, and quick decision-making skills, while providing a platform for students to showcase their knowledge and interest in India's history and governance.

DETAILS:

The School of Law at ARKA JAIN University organized a Quiz Competition as part of the Independence Day Week – Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations on 11th August 2025. The event was held at Room no.534,E block , Nagarjuna Building , School of Law, and witnessed enthusiastic participation from 24 students representing various semesters.

The quiz focused on:

- India's freedom struggle and key historical events.
- Constitutional provisions and their significance.
- Fundamental Rights and Duties.
- Important leaders and their contributions.





• Landmark amendments and judicial interpretations.

Students actively participated in multiple engaging rounds, including General Awareness, Constitutional Knowledge, and Rapid Fire, showcasing their grasp of India's democratic principles and historical milestones. The competition encouraged quick thinking, teamwork, and knowledge application in a spirited yet friendly environment. The Quiz was conducted through Quizizz app where 50 questions were posted. The programme also included brief discussions highlighting the importance of constitutional values, the sacrifices of freedom fighters, and the relevance of democratic principles in the present day.

All faculty members of the School of Law, Programme Co-ordinator Dr. Archita Mishra, and Dean, School of Law, Prof. Dr. Praveen Kumar Thakur, were present and graced the occasion, motivating participants and appreciating their efforts.

Rules of the Event:

The Quiz Competition was conducted through the **Quizizz** application, with **24 students** participating from the School of Law. A total of **50 questions** were posted, covering topics related to the Constitution of India, the nation's struggle for independence, and significant historical events. Participants were given **1 hour** to complete the quiz, which they attempted individually using their mobile phones. The rules required each participant to log in to the Quizizz platform with their registered name for identification and fair evaluation. The questions were in **multiple-choice format**, and each carried equal marks. No negative marking was applied. The quiz was designed to not only assess knowledge but also enhance familiarity with AI-based learning tools, as students interacted with a real-time, automated quiz interface.

Participants were expected to maintain academic integrity, attempt the quiz without any external assistance, and ensure stable internet connectivity during the competition. The scores were automatically generated by the Quizizz platform, ensuring transparency and efficiency in evaluation. The top scorers were declared winners based on their accuracy and completion time.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOME):

The Quiz Competition served as an engaging and educational platform that deepened students' knowledge of India's Constitution and freedom struggle while fostering a spirit of healthy competition. The use of the **Quizizz** app not only made the event interactive but also





strengthened students' familiarity with AI-based educational tools, enhancing their digital literacy.

Through the 50-question format, participants demonstrated quick thinking, accuracy, and a comprehensive understanding of constitutional provisions, historical events, and patriotic values. The instant scoring system provided by the platform ensured fairness and transparency in the evaluation process.

The competition encouraged students to revisit important milestones in India's journey to independence, reflect on the sacrifices of freedom fighters, and appreciate the enduring relevance of constitutional principles in modern governance. The event also promoted self-learning, time management, and the ability to perform under pressure.

Overall, the programme successfully combined technology with knowledge-sharing, inspiring participants to become more informed, responsible, and patriotic members of society.
