OBJECTIVE:

On August 18, 2025, the Department of Optometry at Arka Jain University, Jamshedpur, organized an educational trip for the 1st Year Optometry students aimed at enhancing their practical knowledge and providing experiential learning beyond the classroom environment. The primary goal of the trip was to offer students an opportunity to gain hands-on exposure and a broader understanding of relevant scientific and professional domains. This initiative was designed to complement theoretical studies with real-world insights, thereby fostering holistic academic growth.

The educational trip provided the first-year Optometry students with valuable real-world insights that extended far beyond textbook learning. By visiting the Rusi Modi Centre for




