OBJECTIVE:

The purpose of organizing a code of conduct session in university is to provide a framework for ethical behaviour, foster a respectful and inclusive campus environment, and prepare students to become responsible and ethical members of society. Such sessions also contribute to building a positive campus culture, supporting students' personal growth, and enhancing their ability to make ethical decisions—an essential skill for their future professional and personal endeavours.

DETAILS:

The Code of Conduct session, held as part of the AARAMBH 2025 orientation and induction program at the School of Pharmacy, ARKA JAIN University, aimed to educate and engage students on the importance of ethical behaviour while fostering a positive, respectful, and inclusive campus environment. The session was led by Ms. Priyabati Choudhury, Assistant Professor at the School of Pharmacy, and reflected the University's commitment to nurturing a culture of integrity, respect, and responsibility among new students. The program commenced with an introduction by Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo, who gave an overview of the session, highlighting the meaning of ethics, the significance of ethical behaviour, and key ethical principles. Following this, Ms. Priyabati elaborated on various aspects of the code of conduct, covering areas such as General Student Behaviour, Vehicle Parking, Complaints and Grievances, Identity Cards, Acts of Indiscipline, Dress Code, Reporting to Civil Authorities, Zero Tolerance Policies, Responsible Social Media Use, Misconduct and Discrimination, Dignity and Respect, Reporting Incidents, and Disciplinary Actions. She also emphasized the consequences of violating the code of conduct and the broader impact of unethical behaviour on both individuals and the community. Students were encouraged to raise questions, seek clarifications. The session concluded with a feedback activity, allowing students to share their insights and learning experiences. This program was conceptualized by Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo and was successfully coordinated by Ms. Priyabati Choudhury and Ms. Sonali Mandal, ensuring its smooth execution and impactful delivery.





TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

The session enhanced students' understanding of ethical behaviour and institutional expectations, fostering a culture of integrity, responsibility, and respect within the university community.




Fig. 4- Active participation of students during the session.


