**OBJECTIVE:** Anti-ragging initiatives are to prevent, prohibit, and address ragging in educational institutions, ensuring a safe and respectful environment for all students. This involves raising awareness about the harmful effects of ragging, implementing and enforcing policies, and promptly responding to and resolving any reported incidents.

**DETAILS:** The "National Anti-Ragging Week 2025" was organised by the School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University. This event was organized under the guidance of the University Grants Commission (UGC), which commenced from August 12th, 2024, to August 18th, 2025. The theme for this year was "YaARI – Youth Against Ragging in India", focusing on creating awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging, promoting mutual respect, harmony, and reinforcing the institution's strict zerotolerance policy against any form of ragging. All activities during the week were held in Block A (Aryabhatta), Room No. 131, and witnessed active participation from nursing students who displayed remarkable enthusiasm and commitment towards the cause.12th August 2025 – Theme Presentation: An introductory session was conducted to elaborate on the theme "YaARI," its significance, and the objectives of the Anti-Ragging Week. 13th August 2025 - Poster Presentation: Students showcased their creativity by designing posters that highlighted the negative impacts of ragging and the importance of a safe and inclusive campus. 14th August 2025 – Essay Writing Competition: Participants expressed their thoughts and perspectives through insightful essays on the theme, emphasizing the emotional, psychological, and social consequences of ragging.15th August 2025 - Nukkad Natak: A street play was performed by the students to raise awareness in a compelling and engaging manner. The performance was well-received and effectively conveyed the anti-ragging message.16th August 2025 – Role Play: Various real-life scenarios related to ragging and conflict resolution were enacted by students, offering practical understanding and empathy-building.18th August 2025 - short Film Screening: A short film based on the theme was screened to conclude the week. The film underscored the importance of student unity, vigilance, and collective responsibility. The Anti-Ragging Week 2025 at the School of Nursing was a resounding success. The weeklong events fostered awareness, unity, and a sense of responsibility among students.






#### **TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):**




Fig 7: Role Play by Bsc nursing students.
