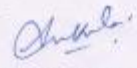

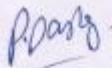

OBJECTIVE: The primary objective of the program was to create awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging, sensitize them to the legal consequences, and encourage a safe, inclusive, and respectful campus culture. The event aimed to reinforce the university's zero-tolerance policy against ragging and promote a friendly environment for all students, especially fresher's.

DETAILS: The Anti-Ragging Awareness Program was organized by Department of Commerce.. The event was conducted with the objective of sensitizing students about the ill effects of ragging, spreading awareness regarding the legal consequences, and reinforcing the university's commitment towards maintaining a ragging-free campus. Faculty members, staff, and students from various courses actively participated in the program, which aimed at creating a safe, inclusive, and supportive environment, especially for the first-year students. The program commenced with a welcome address who highlighted the importance of discipline, respect, and peer support within the academic community. Informative pamphlets, posters, and brochures carrying anti-ragging messages and important helpline numbers were distributed among students for further awareness.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by appreciating the efforts of the organizers, guest speakers, faculty members, and student participants. Overall, the program proved to be highly impactful, as it not only educated the students about the dangers and consequences of ragging but also encouraged them to collectively work towards building a safe and respectful learning environment.

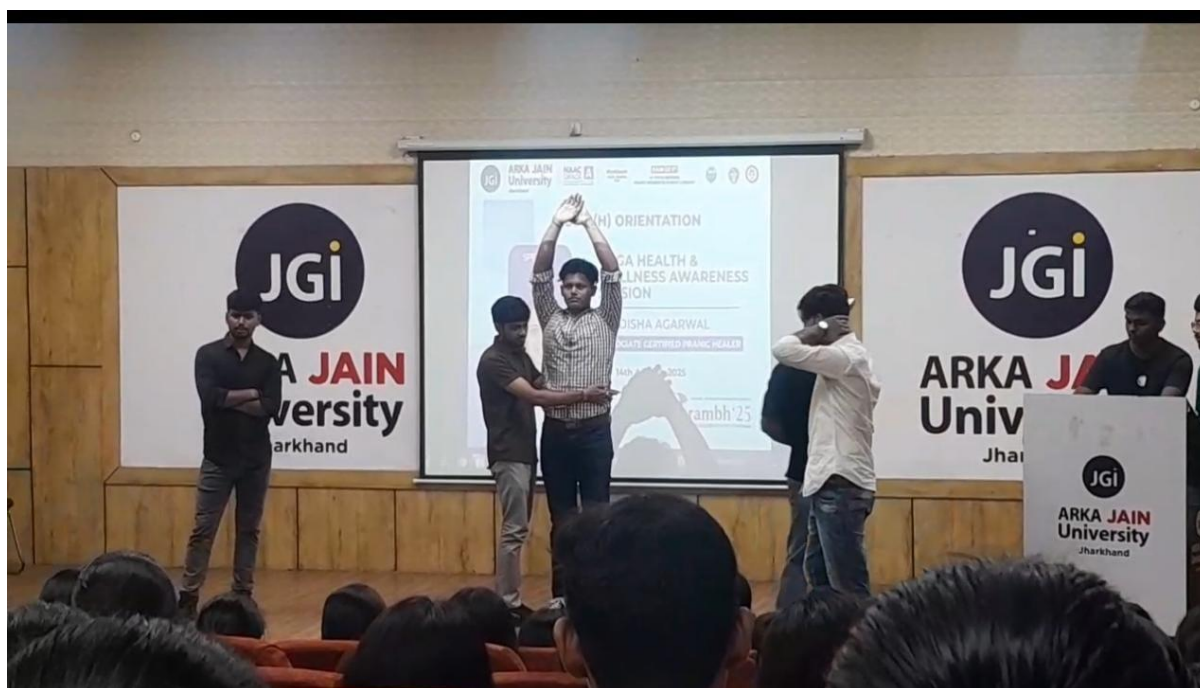


Fig.1- Students engaged in activities



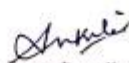
Fig. 2- Students sharing information
