Annexure III

Dos and Don'ts for CPR

Dos:

- Crisure yours and the victim's safety first

 Check responsiveness by tapping on shoulder and shouling "Are you alright?"

 Check response Call for Emergency Services (like 112/108/102) and start chest compressions (CPR)

 If no response Call for Emergency Services (like 112/108/102) and start chest compressions (CPR)

 Ensure that the victim is lying on a firm, filst surface

 Keep your elbows straight while performing chest compressions

 Perform chest compressions at a rate of 101.0120 per minute

 Allow chest to return to normal position before giving the next compression

 Continue CPR till ellier the person is reviewed or medical help arrives

 Use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), if and when available

Don'ts:

- Do NOT panic
 Do NOT delay chest compression
 Do NOT delay chest compression if the victim is conscious
 Do NOT administer chest compression if the victim is conscious
 Do NOT interrupt in between chest compressions
 Do NOT bend your elbows while giving chest compression

OBJECTIVE:

The Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Awareness week initiative aims to enhance awareness, preparedness, and capacities of general public across all sectors in performing CPR.

DETAILS:

A Nation-wide Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Awareness week is being organised by Ministry of Health and Family welfare (MoHFW) from 13th to 17th October 2025, So in this regard School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University is conducted an online Pledge through MyGov portal, Demonstration on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), and an Online Quiz Competition through MyGov portal ,panel discussion on "CPR Techniques and role of bystanders", Mass demonstration on CPR Techniques, Street Play, Poster competition and Awareness Booth as part of the Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Awareness Week.

Day 1(13-10-2025): The program began with an online pledge taking, where students and faculty members took a pledge to promote CPR awareness and encourage others to learn this lifesaving technique. Following the pledge, the event featured a live demonstration of hands-only CPR conducted by medical experts, showcasing the simple steps that can be performed by anyone to save a life during a cardiac emergency was conducted by members of MoHFW. The session included step-by-step guidance on CPR techniques. Participants gained practical understanding of how to provide immediate aid during cardiac arrest situations. To reinforce learning and encourage active participation, an online quiz competition was also organized. Students from various batches participated enthusiastically, testing their knowledge about CPR techniques.

Day 2 (14-10-2025): On the Second Day the Poster Competition was conducted. Participants presented informative posters illustrating the steps, techniques of CPR. The posters were evaluated based on creativity, relevance, presentation, and clarity of message and prize was distributed to the winners and provided certificate of participation to the participants. Following the competition, an Online Panel Discussion was conducted, featuring expert faculty members and healthcare professionals. The session focused on the "CPR technique – A Panellists discussed the CPR technique and the role of bystanders.





Day 3 (15-10-2025): On the third day a Mass Demonstration on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Techniques was organized at MGM Hospital, Dimna, Jamshedpur. Faculty members and nursing students demonstrated the step-by-step procedure of CPR technique, including assessment of the victim, chest compressions and rescue breathing. Participants were also given an opportunity to observe and practice the techniques on mannequins under supervision. The demonstration emphasized the "Hands-only CPR" method for lavpersons.

Day 4 (16-10-2025): On the Fourth day an Awareness Booths on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Techniques was organized in Aryabhtta Block, Room No. 120 to enhance public knowledge about the importance of CPR and its life-saving potential during cardiac emergencies. The awareness booths were designed and managed by nursing faculty and students, who provided demonstrations, visual displays on CPR steps and emergency response. Participants had the opportunity to interact with demonstrators and clarify their doubts.

Day 5 (17-10-2025): On the fifth day a Street Play on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) was conducted at Musarikudar Village, Gamharia to create awareness among the rural community about the importance of CPR and how timely action can save lives during cardiac emergencies. The nursing students performed an engaging and informative street play depicting real-life scenarios where CPR techniques were demonstrated and explained in a simple and practical manner. The Program was conducted under the guidance of Prof. Ginu Anie Joseph (Principal) & Prof. Shilpa J (Vice Principal) School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

The CPR Awareness Week enhanced participants' knowledge and skills regarding cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). Students and healthcare personnel/Public gained a better understanding of the importance of timely intervention during cardiac emergencies. The sessions increased confidence in identifying cardiac arrest, performing chest compressions, and using an automated external defibrillator (AED). Participants became more aware of their role as first responders in saving lives, promoting a culture of preparedness and community responsibility. Overall, the week fostered a sense of awareness, skill competency, and motivation to act promptly in life-threatening situations.




Fig. 9- Group photo of the (CPR) Awareness Week
