### Objective:

The primary objective of an expert talk on gender sensitization is to foster a more equitable and inclusive society by raising awareness of gender equality issues and promoting a change in attitudes and behaviours that perpetuate discrimination.

Key objectives of this talk include:

- **Raising Awareness:** To help participants understand the importance of equality, inclusivity, and respectful communication in professional and academic settings.
- **Challenging Stereotypes:** To examine and question prevailing gender roles, biases, and assumptions in society that limit the potential of all individuals.
- **Promoting Respect and Dignity:** To foster an environment where everyone, regardless of their gender identity, can live and work with respect and dignity.
- **Preventing Harassment and Violence:** To equip individuals with the knowledge and confidence to identify, prevent, and address gender-based discrimination, bullying, and sexual harassment in a timely and just manner.
- **Providing Legal Knowledge:** To familiarize participants with the legal frameworks and institutional policies, such as the **Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act**, that are in place to protect individuals from workplace or campus harassment.

## Details of the Event:

The Department of Biotechnology organized an Expert Talk on Gender Sensitization **“Breaking Stereotypes: Promoting Gender Equality among Youth”** on 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2025. Mrs. Punam Singh Deo, Assistant Teacher deputed in CMSOE, Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya, Seraikela was the resource person. The resource person emphasized the need for mutual respect, breaking gender stereotypes, and promoting equity in academic and professional spheres. She also focused on the Challenges Faced by Transgender Persons like Social exclusion, family rejection, discrimination at school/work, Lack of access to healthcare, education, employment, housing and Mental health impacts due to stigma and violence. She addressed the students on different student support systems and facilities available for students in our university, Specialized Cells and Committees. The event was efficiently coordinated by Ms. Kajal Karishma Faculty Biotechnology.

## Outcomes:

The session on Gender Sensitization enabled a number of positive outcomes for the students of B.Sc. Biotechnology, including a safer and more inclusive work environment. Students shared their experiences with everyone showing the importance of gender equality and improved employee morale and productivity. Specifically, the sessions empowered the students to voice their concerns, promote a culture of respect and accountability, and ensure that grievances are addressed fairly and effectively.

Sessions like these educate students about their rights, available support systems, and the grievance redressal process, empowering them to speak up against any form of harassment or discrimination. By creating a safe space for discussion, the session has encouraged students to report grievances without fear of retaliation, leading to a more effective and timely resolution of issues.

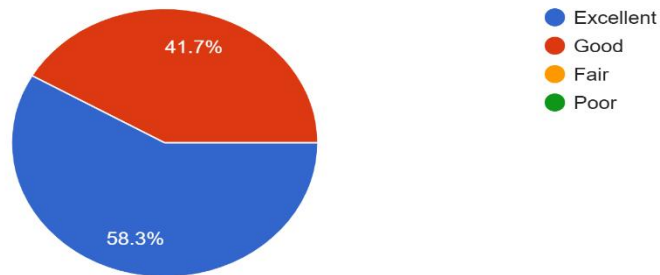

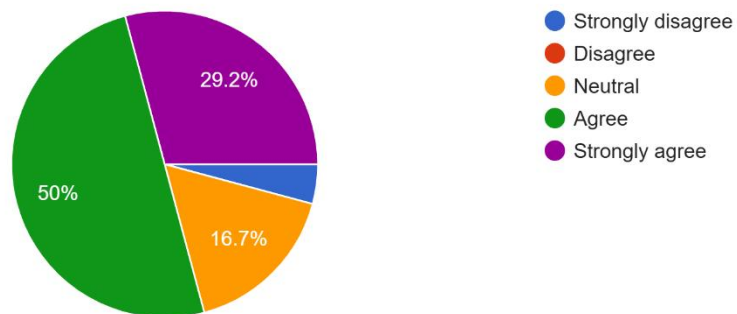
1. How would you rate the overall gender sensitization session?

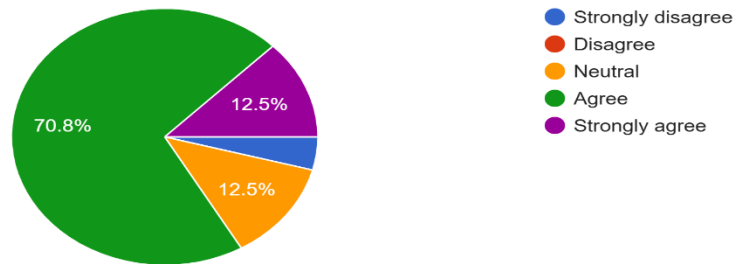
