

PANEL DISCUSSION ON OCULAR TRAUMA: PEVENTION AND MANAGEMENT

OBJECTIVE:

The primary objective of the *Panel Discussion on Ocular Trauma: Prevention and Management* was to enhance the clinical competence of optometry students by providing them with comprehensive insights into the identification, assessment, and management of ocular trauma cases. The program aimed to equip participants with a deeper understanding of various types of ocular injuries, their underlying mechanisms, and the immediate actions required in emergency scenarios. Another key objective was to emphasize the crucial role of optometrists in early detection, primary care, and referral pathways to prevent long-term visual complications. Through expert guidance from experienced clinicians, the event sought to strengthen students' diagnostic reasoning, improve their ability to make informed decisions under pressure, and promote evidence-based approaches in trauma care. Additionally, the session aimed to foster professional readiness by encouraging active participation, critical thinking, and the application of theoretical knowledge to real-world clinical situations, ultimately preparing students to deliver safer and more effective patient care.

DETAILS:

The *Panel Discussion on Ocular Trauma: Prevention and Management* held on **06 November 2025** was an intensive and highly engaging academic program organized by the **Department of Optometry, ARKA JAIN University**, in collaboration with its MoU partner institutes. Coordinated by **Ms. Bhavana**, the event aimed to expose students to advanced clinical perspectives through the expertise of two distinguished professionals—**Mr. Krushna Gopal Panda, Associate Optometrist at the prestigious L V Prasad Eye Institute**, and **Mr. Raman Kumar, Optometry Head at L J Eye Institute, Ambala**. The event began with a formal introduction of the speakers, followed by a comprehensive overview of ocular trauma, its rising prevalence, and the role of primary eye-care professionals in reducing visual morbidity. Throughout the session, the speakers delved deeply into the classification of ocular injuries, differentiating between

blunt, penetrating, chemical, thermal, and non-accidental trauma, while also discussing common real-life causes observed in clinical practice.

The panelists presented a series of case studies illustrating emergency management strategies, diagnostic decision pathways, and the importance of timely referral to prevent permanent visual impairment. Students were guided through the interpretation of clinical signs, use of specialized diagnostic tools, and essential first-aid procedures critical during the initial moments of ocular injury. Special emphasis was given to the importance of patient counseling, preventive safety measures, and interprofessional collaboration in trauma care. The interactive format allowed students to ask questions, analyze scenarios, and refine their approach to handling trauma cases under expert supervision. The session concluded with a reflective discussion on common challenges faced in community and hospital settings, emerging advancements in ocular trauma management, and the evolving responsibilities of optometrists in a multidisciplinary eye-care environment. Overall, the event served as a comprehensive learning platform, significantly broadening the clinical understanding and professional confidence of the participating students.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

The panel discussion provided students with a comprehensive understanding of ocular trauma and significantly enhanced their clinical awareness and decision-making skills. Participants gained in-depth knowledge of the various types of ocular injuries, their causes, and the critical importance of early intervention in preventing long-term visual complications. Through real case examples presented by the speakers, students learned how to interpret clinical signs, prioritize management steps in emergency situations, and identify red-flag symptoms that require immediate referral. The session strengthened their confidence in handling trauma cases by exposing them to practical first-aid measures, diagnostic considerations, and structured treatment approaches.

The speakers' insights also emphasized the role of optometrists within a multidisciplinary eye-care team, helping students understand how effective communication and timely referrals contribute to better patient outcomes. Additionally, attendees recognized the value of preventive eye-care strategies, patient education, and the use of protective measures to reduce the incidence of ocular injuries. The interactive nature of the discussion encouraged critical thinking, collaboration, and active participation, leaving students more motivated and professionally prepared to manage ocular trauma in real-world clinical settings.

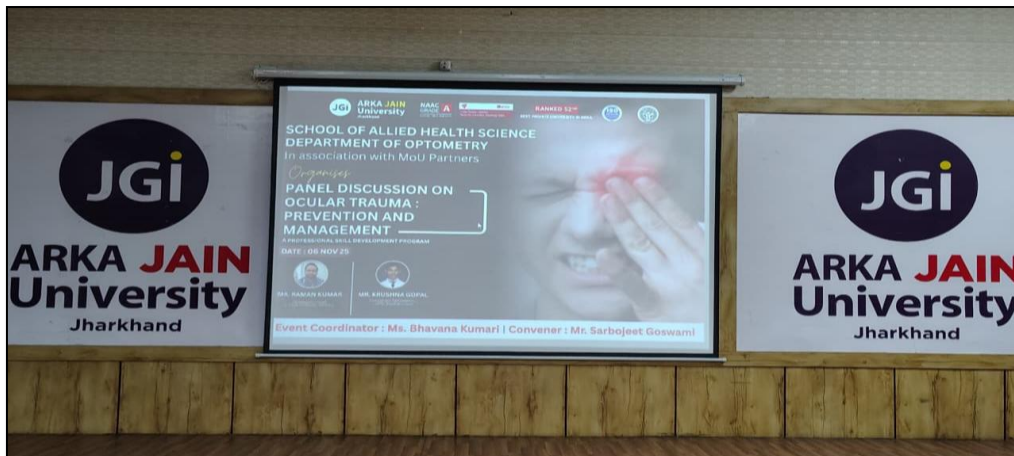


Fig 1. Panel discussion: Ocular Trauma- Prevention and Management

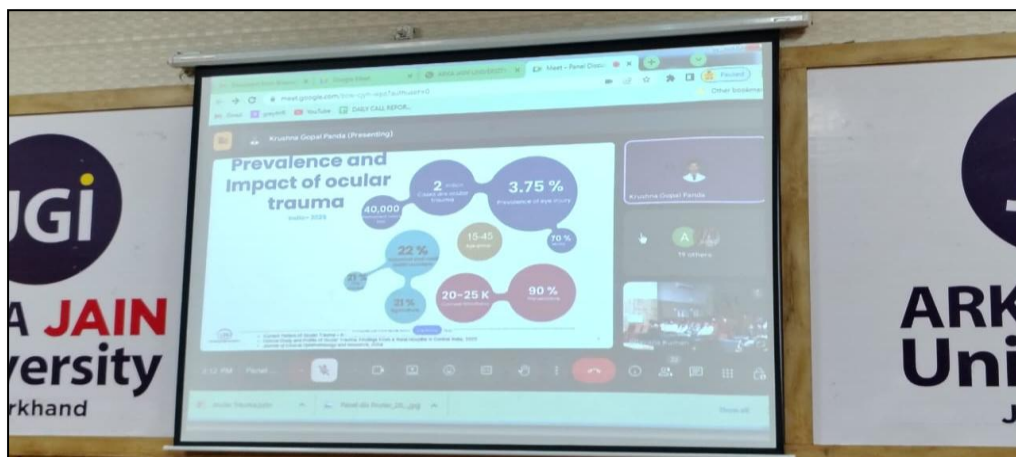


Fig 3 Glimpse of the Presentation

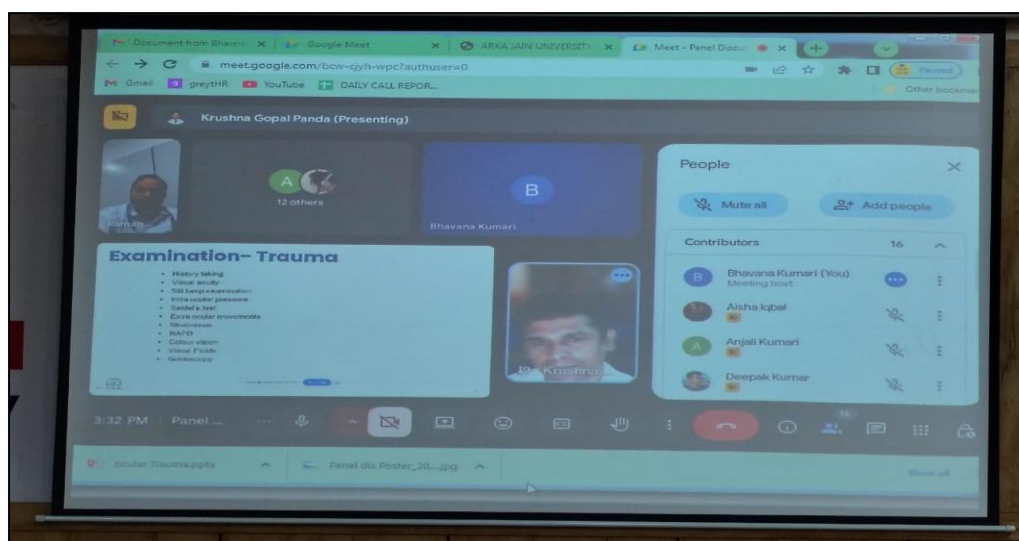




Fig 4. Speakers for the day: Mr. Krushna Gopal Panda and Mr. Raman Kumar
