#### **OBJECTIVE:**

To spread awareness about the conservation and protection of elephants, especially in the Dalma Wildlife region.

#### **DETAILS:**

The NSS volunteers of ARKA JAIN University actively participated in the "Walk for Gajraj" programme held on 3 October 2025. The event was a remarkable initiative of the Forest Department, East Singhbhum, Dalma Range, aimed at spreading awareness about the conservation and protection of elephants, especially in the Dalma Wildlife region.
