#### **OBJECTIVE:**

The objective of this program is to support newly admitted nursing students in adapting smoothly to the academic, clinical, social, and cultural environment of the institution. It aims to foster a strong sense of belonging and prepare students for the challenges of nursing education. The program focuses on familiarizing students with the institutional policies, academic expectations, and clinical responsibilities. It promotes bonding and teamwork, bridges the knowledge gap, and enhances academic orientation.

#### **DETAILS:**





**Fig. 65. Students visited to THM, TINPLATE Hospital**




**Fig. 66. Students Visited CHC, Gamharia**




