NOTICE

This is to inform all the hostel residents availing the university resident facility that the University has initiated a Medical Insurance Policy for the welfare and safety of students residing in the hostel. This initiative is aimed at providing medical coverage in case of any health-related emergencies during the stay in the university hostel.

In this regard, students who have not arranged for their medical insurance on their own are required to pay an amount of approximately ₹3000/- towards the same. Such students who have their own medical insurance don't need to pay. The payment must be made on or before **10th May, 2026** to the Hostel Warden.

Note that the health insurance coverage would begin around the date as mentioned above. Further, the coverage is for one year from the date of issuance of the medical card. Also, if a student decides to discontinue the hostel facility before the end of the academic year, the insurance coverage would cease to exist immediately.

Students are hereby reminded that this provision was already communicated and clearly mentioned in the **Hostel Application Form 2025–26 under Guideline for Students using university provided Accommodation (Point No. 8** Having medical insurance coverage is crucial for students, and it's great that the university is taking steps to ensure they're protected. If students don't have their own insurance, the university's plan can provide a safety net. However, it's also important for students to be aware of the charges associated with the university's plan and factor that into their expenses), and in **Annexure –III** you have signed undertaking in which it is clearly mentioned in **(Point No. 1 (d)** I understand that if I opt for medical insurance as provided by the university, I need to bear the charges in this regard as communicated) therefore, compliance in this regard is mandatory. All students are advised to adhere to the deadline to avoid any inconvenience or complications in availing the insurance benefits.
