OBJECTIVE:

To nurture intellectual engagement, promoting youth leadership, enhancing democratic dialogue, and fostering a spirit of social responsibility among young participants.

DETAILS:

Yuva Gyan Samagam-2026 was a two-day youth-centric academic, intellectual, and leadership development programme organized by the Jharkhand State Youth Commission on 17th and 18th January 2026 in Ranchi. The programme aimed at nurturing intellectual engagement, promoting youth leadership, enhancing democratic dialogue, and fostering a spirit of social responsibility among young participants from various educational institutions across the state.

The event served as a platform for students to engage in constructive discourse, competitive academic activities, and interaction with policymakers, administrators, and youth leaders.

A contingent of four NSS volunteers, Kundan Kumar Tiwary, Yogeshwar Yadav, Zubia Perween and Anjali Singh from ARKA JAIN University participated in the programme under the able mentorship and guidance of Dr. Manoj Kumar Pathak. The participation reflected the university's commitment to youth empowerment, leadership training, and civic engagement through the National Service Scheme (NSS).

The registration process for the participants was completed on 16 January 2026, a day prior to the commencement of the programme. The speeches inspired students to actively participate in academic discourse, social transformation, and public service.

Multiple rounds of quiz competitions were conducted. Questions focused on general knowledge, governance, youth policies, constitutional values, social issues, and contemporary affairs. 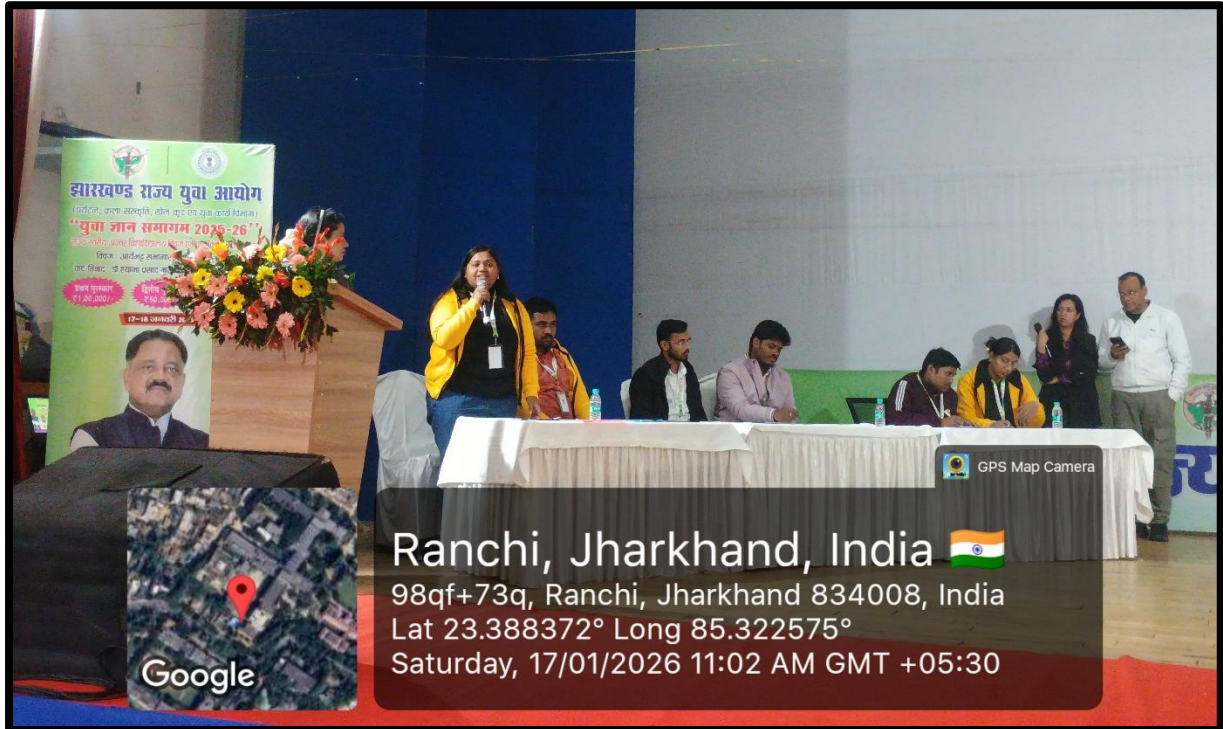


Fig.4- Anjali Singh & Kundan Tiwary taking part in the Debate


