

WORKSHOP ON “ADVANCING NURSING RESEARCH COMPETENCIES”

OBJECTIVE:

To enhance the research competencies of nursing professionals by providing a comprehensive understanding of various aspects of nursing research. The workshop aimed to cover the entire research process, from identifying research problems to the application of research findings.

DETAILS:

The School of Nursing at ARKA JAIN University, in collaboration with the Research and Development Cell was organized a workshop titled "Advancing Nursing Research Competencies", Held from February 23rd to 27th, 2026, at the JEH Auditorium, Block-Aryabhata, the event catered to nursing professionals, faculty, and students engaged in research. The workshop featured a distinguished panel of resource persons, including experienced educators and experts from ARKA JAIN University's School of Nursing, School of Pharmacy, and SCOM, along with a guest speaker, Dr. Daisy Abraham, from P.G. College of Nursing, Chhattisgarh. Day 1, February 23-2026: The workshop commenced with an official welcome by the Principal, Ms. Ginu Anie Joseph, followed by an address by Dr. Sonia Riyat, Head of the Research Department. The inauguration featured a lamp-lighting ceremony by distinguished dignitaries, including Prof. Dr. S. S. Razi, Chairperson of the Board of Management. After the pre-test, participants were introduced to nursing research concepts and problem identification through practical sessions led by Dr. Urvashi Thakur and Ms. Sagarika Barik. The day concluded with a session on formulating objectives and hypotheses in research. Day 2, February 24-2026: The second day focused on exploring literature, building background knowledge, and designing studies. Dr. Shweta and Ms. Sagarika Barik discussed locating evidence, reviewing literature, and searching academic and clinical platforms. The afternoon session covered various research approaches, including historical, survey, and experimental designs, as well as qualitative and quantitative approaches. The day concluded with a practical session on gathering evidence using questionnaires and interviews. Day 3, February 25-2026: The third day concentrated on research ethics, data collection methods, and sampling techniques. The first session on Methods and Tools for Data Collection was conducted by Dr. Ankita Singh, who explained observational methods and record analysis in research.

A session on “Implementing Ethical Guidelines in Research Practice” was conducted by Dr. Abhishek Upadhaya, emphasizing ethical considerations such as informed consent, confidentiality, and responsible research practices. The next session on Conducting a Pilot Study was delivered by Mr. Sumanta Sen, explaining the importance of pilot studies before implementing full research projects. Another important session was conducted by Dr. Urvashi Thakur, who discussed sampling strategies, population and sample concepts, and factors influencing sampling techniques. She also explained validity and reliability of research instruments. The afternoon session on Communication of Research was conducted by Dr. Lata Purohit, who guided students on effectively presenting research findings. Day 4, February 26-2026: The fourth day of the workshop focused on statistical methods used in research. The morning session on Basics of Statistics and Data Analysis was conducted by Dr. Sonia Riyat and Mr. Ratan Kumar Singh. They introduced statistical concepts including frequency distribution, graphical presentation of data, mean, median, mode, standard deviation Normal Probability, Tests of Significance, and Correlation, which helped students understand how statistical methods are applied in research studies. Students also learned about organizing research data and interpreting results using statistical techniques. Day 5, February 27-2026: The final day focused on communicating and applying research findings. Dr. Daisy Abraham, from P.G. College of Nursing, emphasized scientific writing excellence, publication ethics, and how to present research findings effectively. The day also included a post-test to assess the knowledge gained throughout the workshop. The event concluded with a valedictory session and vote of thanks by Mrs Priyanka Tudu, Asst. Prof. of the School of Nursing. This event was conducted under the guidance of Prof Mrs Ginu Anie Joseph, Principal, Dr. Sonia Riyat, Associate Professor, Prof. Shilpa J, Vice Principal, School of Nursing. The event was coordinated by Mrs. Priyanka Tudu, Assistant Professor and Mrs Sagarika Barik, Assistant Professor, School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

The workshop effectively met its objectives, equipping participants with practical skills in all stages of nursing research. Key outcomes included enhanced research skills, improved statistical competence, increased ethical awareness, and better communication of research findings through scientific writing and presentations.

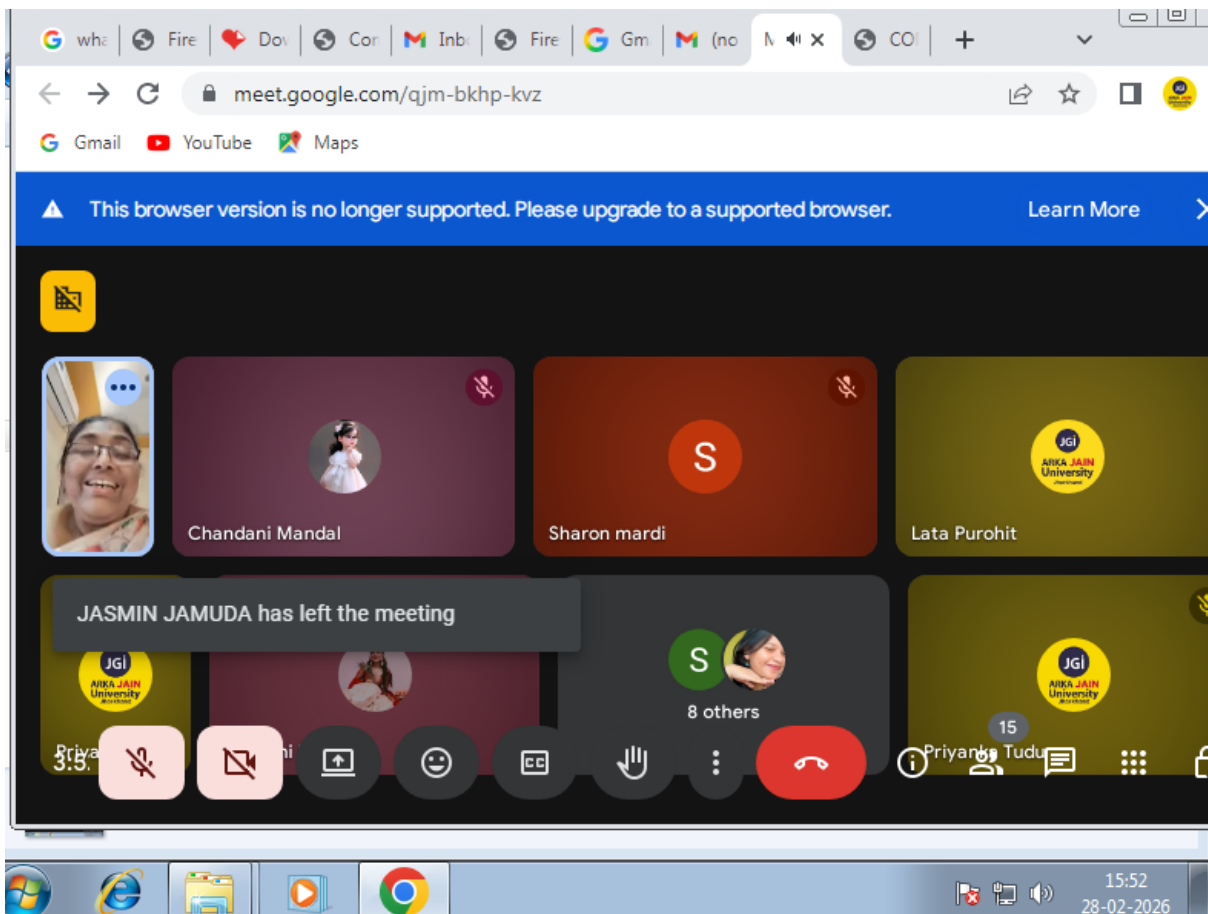


Fig. 4- Dr. Daisy Abraham taking the session on Communication and Research.
