OBJECTIVE:

To focus on shattering stigma, promoting early detection and treatment, ensuring dignity for those affected, and highlighting that leprosy is curable and aiming to eliminate fear, discrimination, and preventable disabilities through increased awareness and community action.

DETAILS:





On 30th January 2026, the School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University in association with National Scheme Services (NSS), Student Nurses Association of India(SNAI) and the Samaritan Club organized an awareness program under the flagship of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan at Mohanpur, Gamharia, Saraikela-Kharsawan, Jharkhand to observe World Leprosy Day with the theme “Leprosy is curable; but stigma remains real challenge.” The program commenced at 10:00 AM. The event was actively conducted by the nursing students and featured activities such as awareness speeches on the eradication of leprosy and a role-play skit portraying real-life experiences of individuals affected by Leprosy (Hansen’s disease). The program focused on educating the public about the causes, signs, symptoms, prevention, and treatment of leprosy while emphasizing the importance of eliminating social stigma. The initiative aimed to promote empathy, understanding, and acceptance within the community. We extend our sincere appreciation to the community members for their enthusiastic participation, cooperation, and support. The program was conducted under the guidance and supervision of Prof. Mrs. Ginu Anie Joseph (Principal). 
