



THE DRIVER'S DRISHTI EYE CAMP

OBJECTIVE:

On February 3rd, 2026, the Department of Optometry, School of Allied Health Science at ARKA JAIN University (AJU), in an impactful collaboration with ASG Eye Hospital, successfully conducted the "The Drivers Drishti Eye Camp". The event was held at the A-Block Conference Room and specifically targeted the university's transport staff to ensure their visual health and, by extension, the safety of the entire university community. The primary aim of the Drivers Drishti campaign was to ensure university road safety by providing drivers with free, professional eye screenings to detect vision impairments. By collaborating with ASG Eye Hospital to offer free cataract surgeries, the event focused on removing financial barriers to essential healthcare, ensuring that those responsible for student and staff transit maintain the visual clarity necessary for safe driving.

DETAILS:

On February 3rd, 2026, with a warm welcome session event commenced, setting an engaging and respectful tone for the day. This was followed by the traditional lamp lighting ceremony, performed by the dignitaries and faculty members present, and symbolizing the inauguration and the safety of the entire community.

The event was executed as a comprehensive community outreach project centered around a diagnostic hub established at the AJU Campus by the Department of Optometry in collaboration with ASG Eye Hospital. Throughout the day, bus drivers and conductors arrived at the campus hub for systematic screenings conducted under professional supervision. The clinical workflow began with detailed case history taking, followed by visual acuity measurements using Snellen's charts to assess distance and near vision. A key technical focus involved performing both objective and subjective refraction—including procedures such as retinoscopy—to ensure each participant received a professional and accurate evaluation. Most notably, the program provided a seamless screening process that transitioned directly from diagnosis to treatment; any driver diagnosed with a cataract was immediately referred and sent for surgery at ASG Eye

Hospital at free of cost. This initiative significantly assisted individuals with cost-cutting by removing financial barriers to specialized care. By ensuring better vision for the transport staff, the campaign serves as a critical measure to avoid any mishaps or accidents that could occur due to impaired sight during driving.

TAKEAWAY:

The campaign demonstrated a significant impact by directly improving the ocular health of the transport workforce and, by extension, the safety of the entire university community. By identifying individuals needing urgent intervention and providing them with free cataract surgeries, the camp delivered immediate, life-changing medical benefits. The high level of engagement and positive feedback underscored the success of the session in promoting health consciousness and reinforcing the importance of regular eye check-ups. Furthermore, for the student volunteers and the Department of Optometry, the event served as a vital lesson in clinical empathy and community health management, offering practical experience in translating complex diagnostic findings into accessible health advice and actionable surgical referrals.

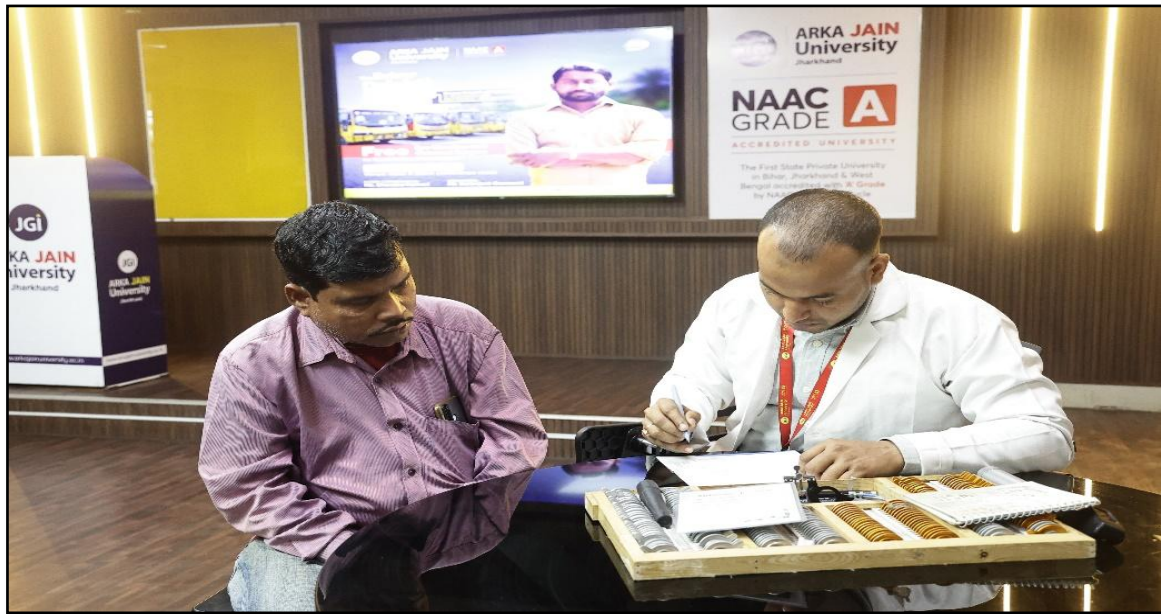


Fig 1: Detailed case history taken before starting the examination procedure

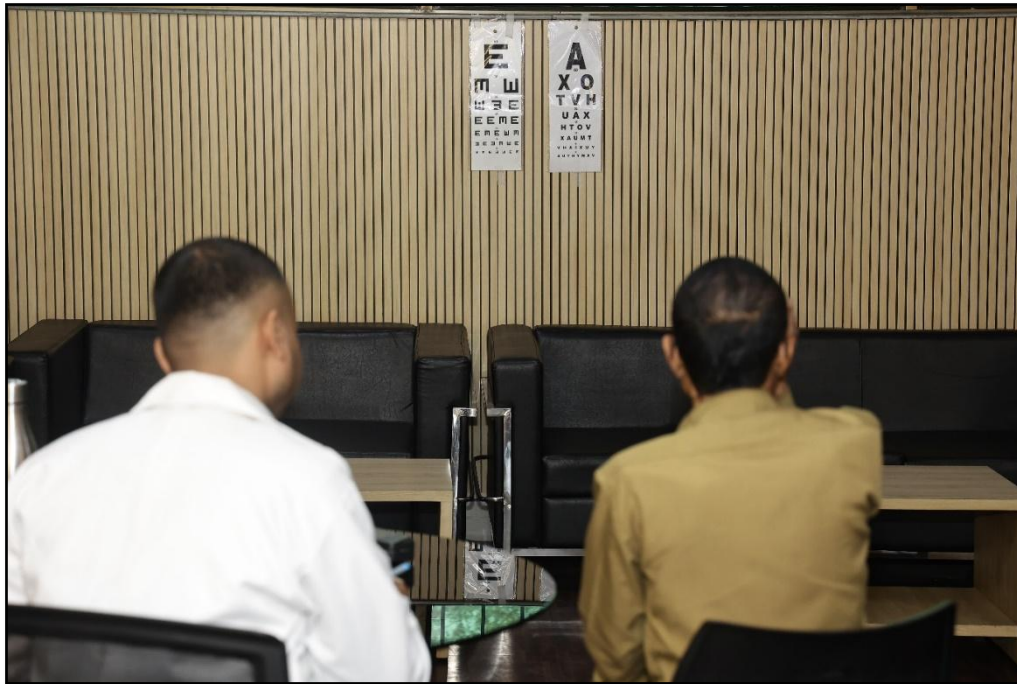


Fig 3: Visual acuity test
