OBJECTIVE:

The recent visit of New Primary School at Musarikudar by AJU law students, organized under the AJU Nyaya Samarthan Cell in collaboration with AJU Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell, aimed to spread awareness on the Right to Education under the Constitution of India. The program sought to sensitize children, parents, and the local community about education as a fundamental right and highlight the provisions of the Right to Education Act, 2009, ensuring free and compulsory education for children aged 6–14 years. It also encouraged parents to send their children to school regularly, reduce dropout rates, and promote inclusivity in learning. The initiative further emphasized empowerment through education, fostering equality, and contributing to the overall socio-economic development of the community.

DETAILS:

An Awareness Program on the Right to Education was organized by AJU Naya Samarthan Cell under the School of Law in association with AJU Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell on 10th September 2025 at New Primary School, Musrikudar (Code-20200413601). The programme was inaugurated by Prof. (Dr.) Praveen Kumar Thakur, Dean-in-Charge, School of Law, who highlighted the importance of village school visits in spreading awareness on **‘Right to Education’ (Free and compulsory elementary education for all children aged from 6 to 14 years within India)**. Faculty members, law students from both BBA LL.B. and LL.B. courses, and UBA volunteers actively participated.
