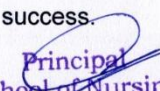

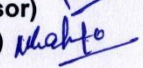
All students are encouraged to actively participate in the program and contribute towards spreading awareness about malaria prevention and control.

To raise awareness about malaria as a major public health problem and to promote efforts toward its prevention, control, and eventual elimination & to educate communities on the causes, transmission, symptoms, and preventive measures of malaria, encourage early diagnosis and timely treatment,

DETAILS:

School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University, in association with the Student Nurses Association of India (SNAI), Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), Samaritan – The Nursing Club, and the National Service Scheme (NSS), organized an awareness program on the occasion of World Malaria Day on 24th April 2026 at Mohanpur Village, starting from 09:00 AM onwards. The program was conducted under the global theme, “Driven to End Malaria: Now We Can. Now We Must.” The program was to educate the community people about malaria prevention, early diagnosis, and effective treatment measures. The program commenced with an introductory session highlighting the significance of World Malaria Day and the global efforts to eliminate malaria. Nursing students actively participated in spreading awareness through health education sessions and interactive discussions. They explained the causes, modes of transmission, common signs and symptoms, and preventive strategies such as the use of mosquito nets, maintaining sanitation, and eliminating stagnant water. The event proved to be highly beneficial in enhancing the knowledge and awareness of the Community people while also providing practical learning experience to the nursing students.
