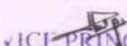

The meeting helps parents and students understand the academic structure and expectations of the institution, including rules and regulations, examination guidelines, attendance requirements, and internal assessment criteria.

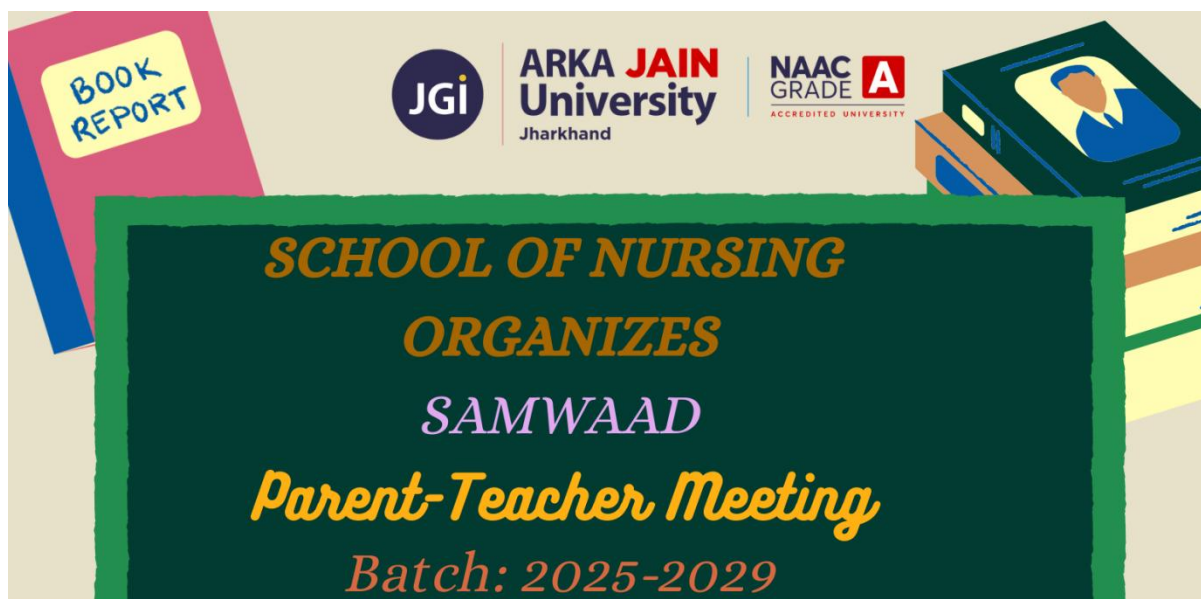
DETAILS:

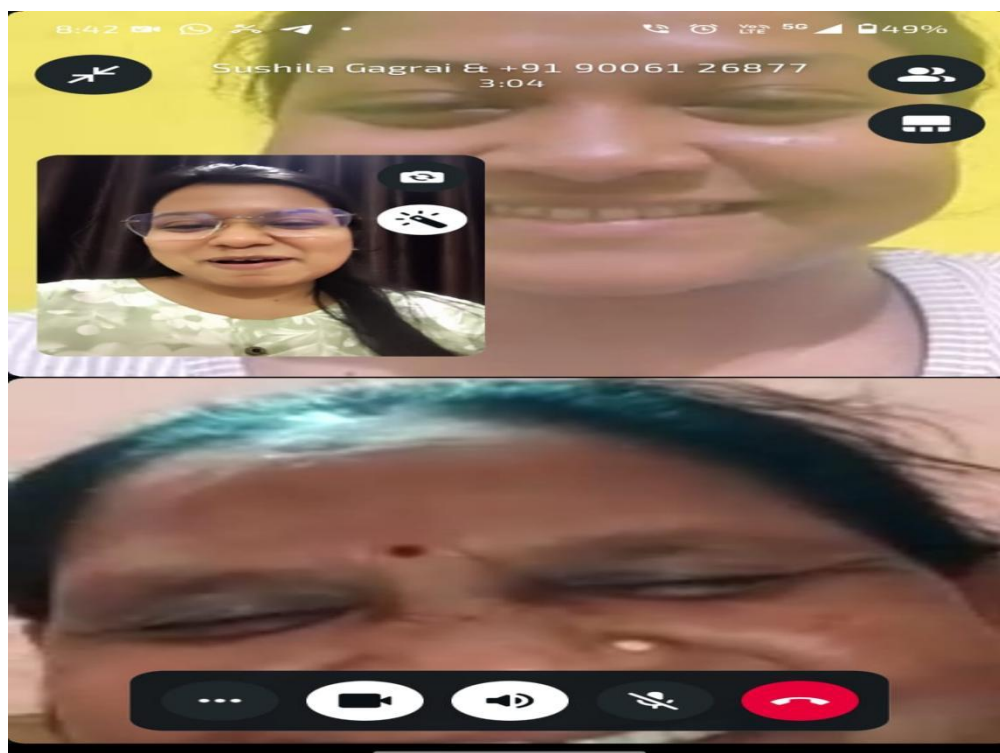


Fig.02. Mentors are conducting online Parent -Teacher meeting

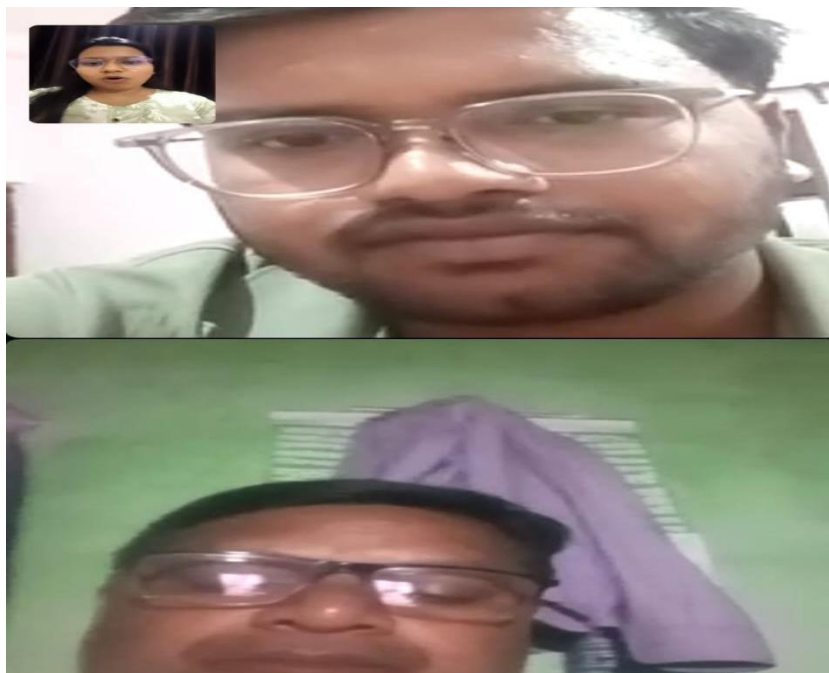


Fig.03. Mentors are conducting online Parent -Teacher meeting

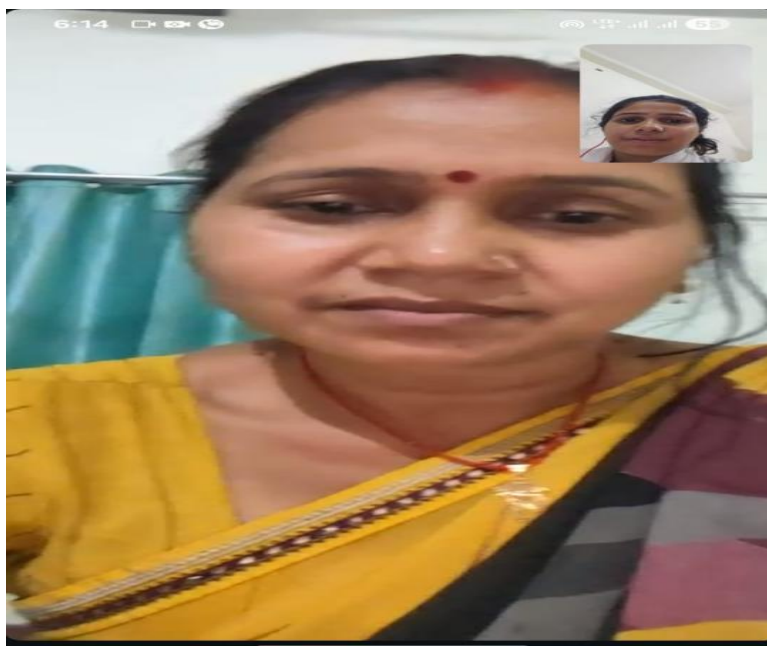


Fig.04. Mentors are conducting online Parent -Teacher meeting

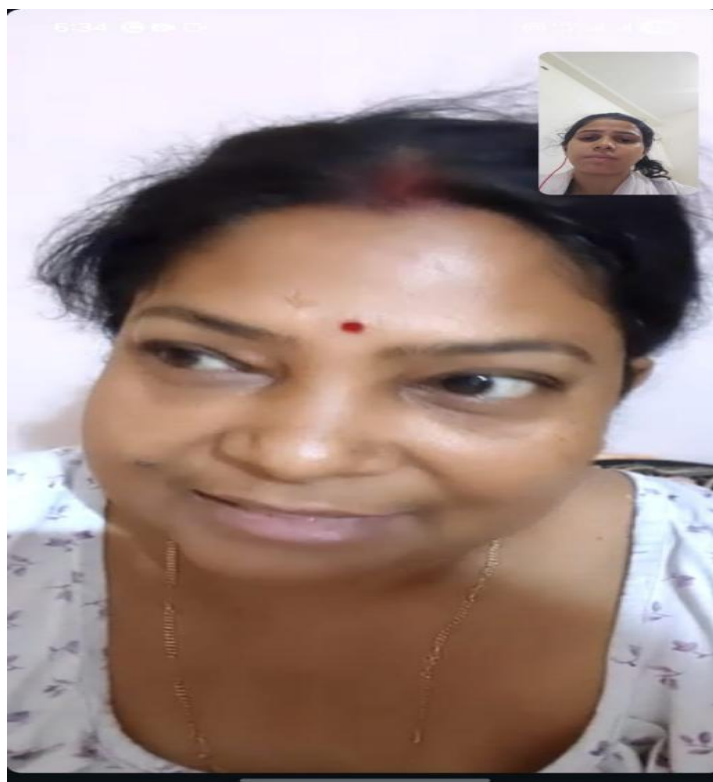


Fig.05. Mentors are conducting online Parent -Teacher meeting
