OBJECTIVE: Intra-moot court competitions serve as a vital pedagogical tool by providing participants with structured opportunities to develop and refine essential legal and advocacy competencies, including legal research, legal writing, oral advocacy, and critical thinking. These competitions enable participants to apply doctrinal legal principles to simulated or hypothetical disputes, thereby fostering practical engagement with the law. In doing so, they effectively bridge the gap between theoretical understanding and the acquisition of applied legal skills.

DETAILS:- The **Intra Moot Court Competition 2026** was conducted by the School of Law, Arka Jain University, as an academic initiative aimed at strengthening experiential legal education. Intra-moot court competitions constitute a significant component of legal pedagogy, as they enable students and aspiring legal professionals to cultivate essential practical skills—such as legal reasoning, advocacy, and analytical thinking—while simultaneously deepening their understanding of the application of legal principles.

Participation in the competition was mandatory, reflecting its integral role in participative learning methodologies adopted by the institution. The event witnessed the involvement of 40 participants, out of which three teams were selected as the best performers.

The competition was conducted across three evaluative rounds. The first round was adjudicated by Advocate Pulak Kumar Sethi; the second round was judged by Advocate Md Arshad Ansari, Civil court, Jamshedpur & Amjad khan, Additional public prosecutor, Garwa; and the final round was adjudicated by Advocate Angsuman Chowdhury, Civil Court Jamshedpur

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES): - The moot court competition served as an effective experiential learning platform, facilitating the identification of winning and runner-up teams, as well as the recognition of outstanding individual participants. It also incorporated structured feedback and evaluation mechanisms, alongside the conferment of awards and incentives, thereby preparing participants for future competitive engagements.

Furthermore, the competition significantly contributed to the enhancement of core legal competencies, including advocacy, analytical reasoning, and legal articulation. It fostered increased confidence among participants, created valuable networking opportunities, and provided practical exposure to courtroom procedures. In addition, it reinforced the importance of legal ethics and professional responsibility, while deepening participants' understanding of substantive and procedural legal principles.
