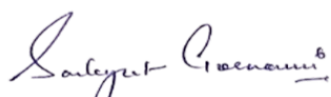

EYE HEALTH AND VISION SCREENING CAMP

OBJECTIVE:

The primary objective of the Eye Screening Camp was to promote community eye health through free eye examinations, enabling early detection and management of vision-related issues. The camp aimed to serve underserved communities by raising awareness about the importance of regular eye check-ups, refractive errors, and other common ocular conditions. It also aimed to connect patients with appropriate eye care services for further treatment and support.

DETAILS:

The Eye Screening Camp was conducted on 18th September 2025 as part of an Outreach Extension Activity by the Department of Optometry at ARKA JAIN University, in collaboration with NSS, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell, and the IKSHANA Club. The camp aimed to extend essential primary eye care services to the community while providing practical exposure to optometry students. The program commenced with a short introductory speech by Mr. Sarbojeet Goswami & Dr. Manoj Kumar Pathak on the importance of eye check-up.

The camp activities included participant registration, visual acuity testing using Snellen's charts, basic refraction. Common ocular conditions such as refractive errors, dry eyes, and cataracts were identified during the screening. Participants received personalized counselling on eye care, proper visual hygiene, and the importance of regular eye check-ups, especially for those working in industrial environments. Educational materials were distributed, and cases requiring further attention were referred to appropriate eye care facilities. All medical findings were carefully documented in the Department of Optometry's Outreach Activity Register at ARKA JAIN University, which was later returned to the campus for further evaluation and record-keeping. The camp ended at

4:00 PM, following which all equipment was systematically packed and transported back to the university.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

The Eye Screening Camp at Tata Steel, Gamharia successfully provided free vision screening to a significant number of employees and staff members, facilitating early identification of common eye conditions such as refractive errors, dry eyes, and early cataracts. Participants diagnosed with potential eye health issues were advised accordingly and referred to nearby specialized eye care centers for further evaluation and treatment. The camp also played a vital role in raising awareness about the importance of regular eye check-ups, particularly in an industrial setting where eye safety is crucial. Additionally, the event offered valuable hands-on experience to the six participating optometry students, enhancing their practical skills in vision testing, patient interaction, and health education. Overall, the collaboration between the Department of Optometry, NSS, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, IKSHANA Club, and Tata Steel proved to be highly effective in promoting community eye health and strengthening institutional outreach efforts.
