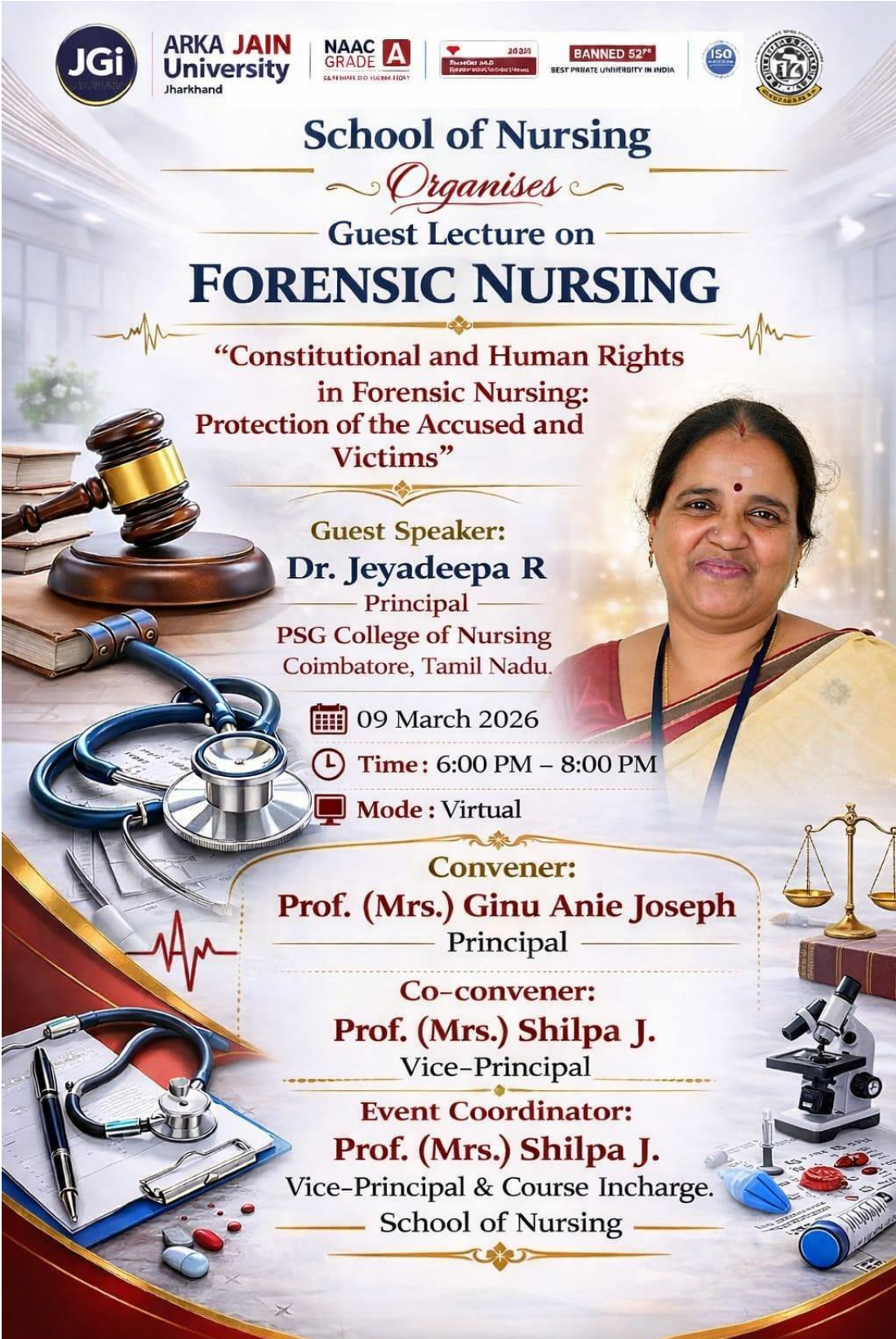
OBJECTIVE:

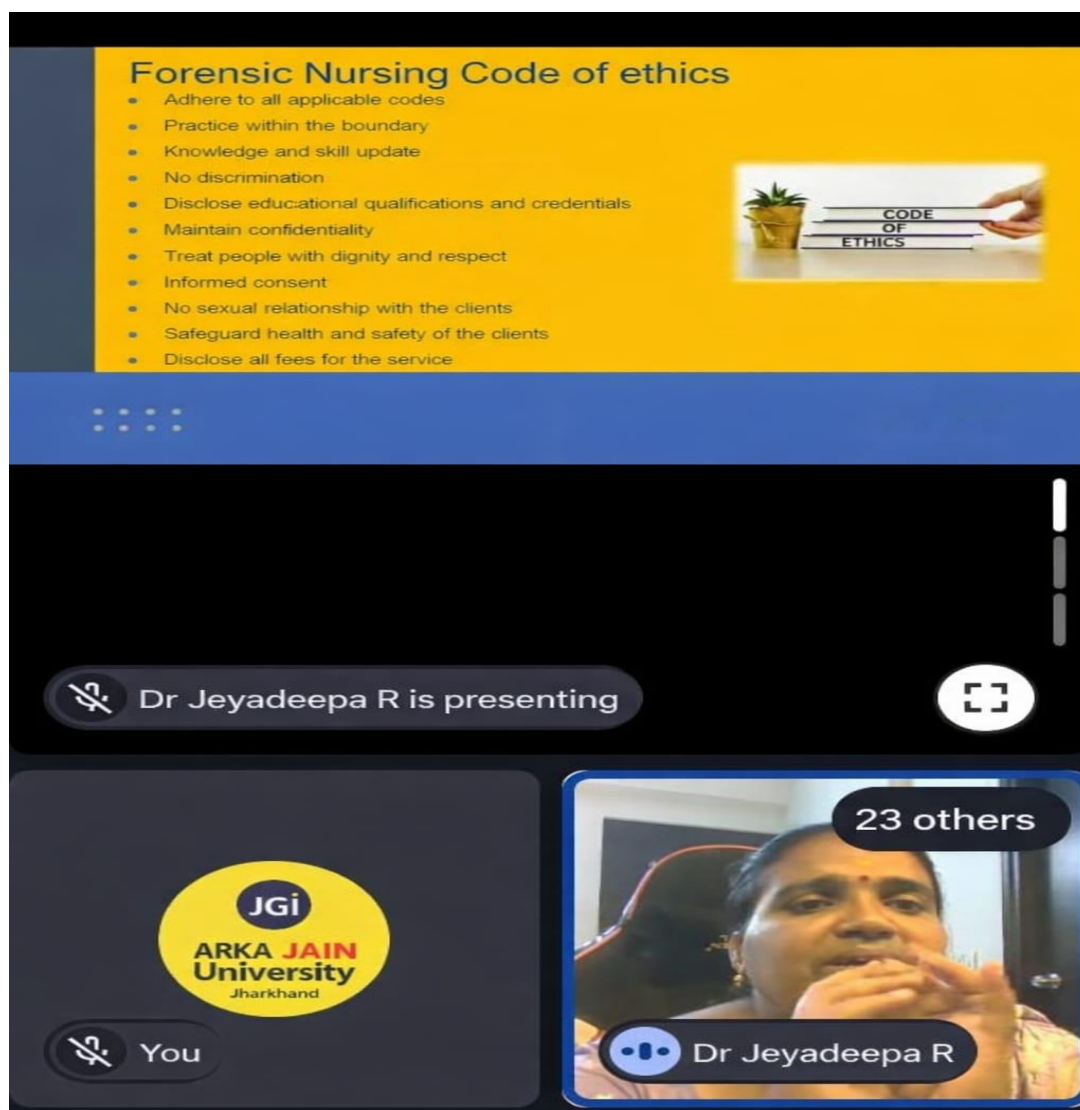


Fig 1: - Students attending the session explained by Dr. Jeyadeepa madam prior to the commencement of the event.

Important principles include:

1. Rule of law
2. Written constitution
3. Limited government
4. Protection of fundamental rights
5. Government of laws, not individuals

Fundamental Rights

Fundamental rights are **basic human rights necessary for freedom and dignity.**

Key points:

1. They are **natural rights**, not gifts from the government.
2. They existed even before the formation of the state.
3. The Constitution only **recognizes and protects them.**

Examples include:

1. Right to life
2. Freedom of speech
3. Freedom of religion
4. Right to equality

However, these rights are **not absolute**. They can be limited for the welfare of society.

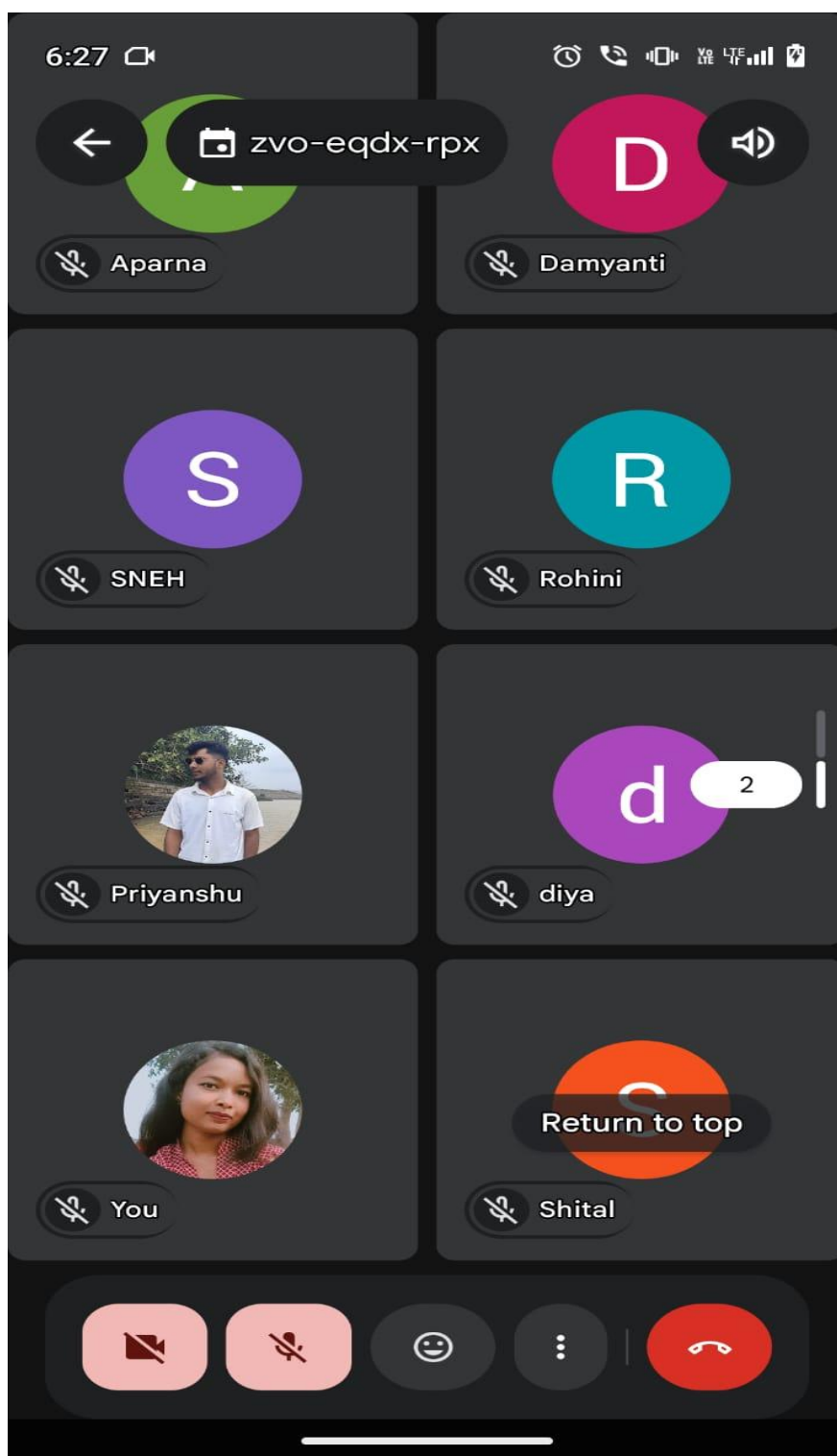


Fig 4 :- Students actively participated in the Lecture session conducted by Dr Jeyadeepa R.
