OBJECTIVE:

To raise awareness about key health issues that affect people worldwide and to promote healthier lifestyles and equitable access to healthcare services and highlight to the importance of preventive measures, research, and education in maintaining health.

DETAILS:

On 7th April 2026, the School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University in collaboration with the Centre for Indian Knowledge System (CIKS), NCC unit and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) along with Student Nurses association of India (SNAI), organized an Extension Activity program at Mohanpur, Gamharia, Saraikela-Kharsawan, Jharkhand to observe World Health Day with the theme "Together of Health and stand with sciences." The program commenced at 10:00 AM. The event was actively conducted by the nursing students with the aim of promoting awareness regarding health, hygiene, and sanitation among the rural population. The program was conducted with active participation of students under faculty guidance. A rally was organized in the village to highlight the importance of safe drinking water, sanitation, and personal hygiene. Students carried flash cards and raised slogans to spread awareness among villagers. A yoga session was conducted to promote physical and mental well-being among villagers. A cleanliness drive was conducted in the Mohanpur village to promote environmental hygiene and encourage community participation in maintaining cleanliness. During the drive, students interacted with villagers, addressing their health-related queries and promoting behavioural changes for better health practices. Additionally, a Nukkad Natak play was performed, focusing on sanitation, hygiene, and safe water practices to raise awareness in an engaging and accessible manner. A Swachh Bharat activity was conducted in the form of a cleanliness drive in selected areas of the village to encourage environmental hygiene. Students also engaged directly with villagers to address their health-related queries and promote positive behavioural changes. A nukkad natak (street play) was performed to effectively communicate messages on sanitation and safe water practices. Additionally, a basic health screening camp was organized where general health check-ups and counselling



were provided to the villagers. A total of 85 participants attended the program. We extend our sincere appreciation to the community members for their enthusiastic participation, cooperation, and support. The program was conducted under the guidance and supervision of Prof. Mrs. Ginu Anie Joseph (Principal). We also express our heartfelt gratitude to the honourable Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Easwaran Iyer and Prof. Dr. Angad Tiwari for providing this valuable opportunity to organize the outreach activity.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

The program was successful in enhancing awareness among villagers regarding hygiene, sanitation, and preventive healthcare practices. The interactive sessions and activities encouraged community participation and motivated villagers to adopt healthier lifestyles. Overall, the initiative contributed positively toward improving health awareness and promoting well-being in the community.

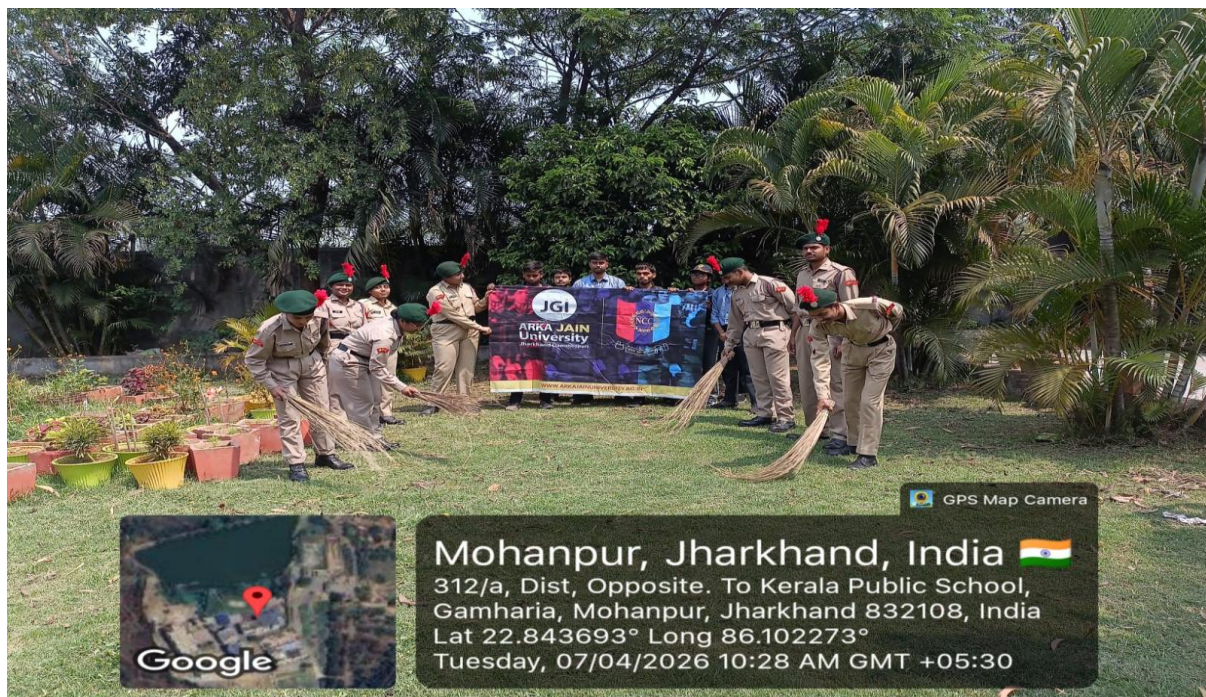


Fig. 4-Students promoting environmental hygiene by the cleanness drive

अरका जैन विश्वविद्यालय के नर्सिंग के छात्रों ने मोहनपुर में चलाया स्वच्छता और स्वास्थ्य का जागरूकता अभियान!

सर्चन्यूज: सच के साथ: विश्व स्वास्थ्य दिवस के अवसर पर अरका जैन विश्वविद्यालय के नर्सिंग स्कूल द्वारा सेंटर फॉर इंडियन नॉलेज सिस्टम (सीआईकेएस), एनसीसी यूनिट और उन्नत भारत अभियान (यूबीए) सेल के सहयोग से तथा एसएनएआई के साथ मिलकर मोहनपुर, गम्हरिया में एक भव्य जागरूकता कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया। कार्यक्रम का विषय था— “स्वास्थ्य के लिए एकजुट हों और विज्ञान के साथ खड़े हों”। कार्यक्रम की शुरुआत सुबह 10:00 बजे हुई, जिसमें नर्सिंग छात्रों ने शिक्षकों के मार्गदर्शन में ग्रामीण समुदाय के बीच स्वास्थ्य, स्वच्छता और साफ-सफाई के प्रति जागरूकता फैलाने में सक्रिय भूमिका निभाई। इस अवसर पर गांव में एक जागरूकता रैली निकाली गई, जिसमें छात्रों ने फ्लैश कार्ड और नारों के माध्यम से सुरक्षित पेयजल, व्यक्तिगत स्वच्छता और साफ-सफाई के महत्व को प्रभावी ढंग से प्रस्तुत किया। ग्रामीणों के शारीरिक और मानसिक स्वास्थ्य को सुदृढ़ करने के उद्देश्य से योग सत्र का भी आयोजन किया गया। साथ ही, मोहनपुर गांव में स्वच्छता अभियान चलाकर पर्यावरण स्वच्छता को बढ़ावा दिया गया और सामुदायिक भागीदारी को प्रोत्साहित किया गया। कार्यक्रम के दौरान छात्रों ने ग्रामीणों से सीधे संवाद स्थापित कर उनके स्वास्थ्य संबंधी प्रश्नों का समाधान किया और स्वस्थ जीवनशैली अपनाने के लिए प्रेरित किया। जागरूकता को रोचक और प्रभावशाली बनाने के लिए नुक्कड़ नाटक का भी मंचन किया गया, जिसमें स्वच्छता और सुरक्षित जल उपयोग का संदेश दिया गया। इसके अतिरिक्त, एक स्वास्थ्य जांच शिविर का आयोजन किया गया, जिसमें ग्रामीणों को बुनियादी स्वास्थ्य जांच और आवश्यक परामर्श प्रदान किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम में कुल 83 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया। समुदाय के लोगों ने उत्साहपूर्वक सहभागिता करते हुए कार्यक्रम को सफल बनाया। कार्यक्रम का सफल संचालन प्रो. श्रीमती जिनु एनी जोसेफ (प्रधानाचार्य) के मार्गदर्शन एवं पर्यवेक्षण में हुआ। इस अवसर को प्रदान करने के लिए विश्वविद्यालय के माननीय प्रतिकुलपति प्रो. डॉ. अंगद तिवारी के प्रति भी आभार व्यक्त किया गया। यह कार्यक्रम न केवल स्वास्थ्य जागरूकता बढ़ाने का माध्यम बना, बल्कि समाज में सकारात्मक परिवर्तन की दिशा में एक सशक्त कदम भी साबित हुआ।
