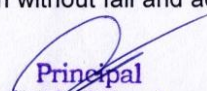

5. Return demonstrations to assess individual competency and reinforce learning
6. Peer learning and guided feedback to enhance critical thinking and clinical decision-making

WORKSHOP ON BASIC CARDIAC LIFE SUPPORT (BCLS)

OBJECTIVE:

To develop a clear understanding of Basic Life Support techniques, train participants in performing Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, Emergency Response system, Bag and mask ventilation.

DETAILS:

A Workshop on Basic Cardiac Life Support (BLS) was organized by School Of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University as the part of the curriculum of Mandatory Module of ADULT HEALTH NURSING -I for 3rd semester (session-2024-2028) on 8th April 2026 at JEH Auditorium from 10am Onwards to equip participants with essential life-saving skills. The workshop aimed to provide both theoretical knowledge and practical training in handling medical emergencies such as cardiac arrest, choking, and unconsciousness. The workshop began with an introductory session explaining the importance of immediate medical assistance during emergencies. The resource person Ms. Debakshi Biswas (certified BLS & ACLS Instructor) demonstrated key techniques including CPR, chest compressions, rescue breathing, and management of choking victims. After that Mrs. Sagarika Barik (Nursing Tutor) demonstrated the simulation-based practice for the students of 3rd semester. Participants were then engaged in hands-on practice sessions using training mannequins under expert supervision. Interactive discussions, real-life case scenarios, and question-answer sessions were also conducted to reinforce learning. Pré-test and post-test sessions are also being conducted to assess their previous knowledge about Basic life Support. After the sessions OSCE exam and written exam has been conducted to evaluate their gained knowledge from the workshop. Total 38 students were present in the session. The program was organized under the supervision of Prof. Ginu Anie Joseph (Principal), Prof. Shilpa. J (Vice Principal). Total 38 students have been participated in the Module.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

The Basic Life Support workshop proved to be highly informative and beneficial. It successfully met its objectives by empowering participants with essential emergency response skills. Such workshops are crucial in preparing individuals to act promptly and responsibly in critical situations, potentially saving lives.

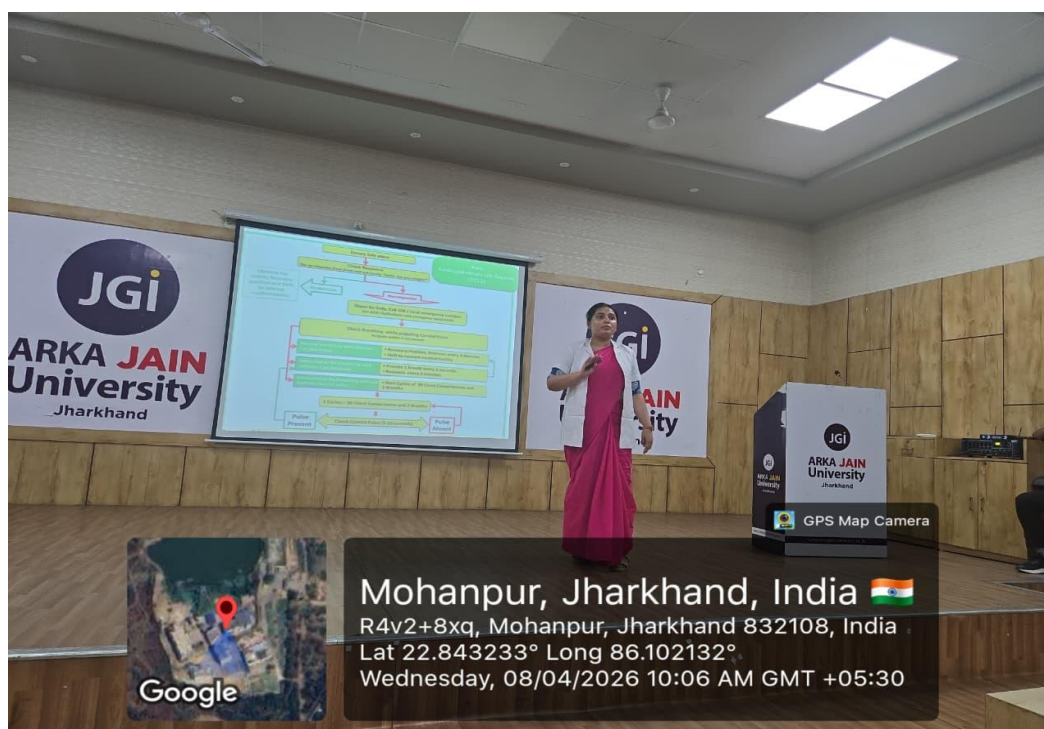


Fig 5: BCLS theory, CPR technique session taken by Ms.Debakshi Biswas (Certified BLS & ACLS instructor)
