OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the Old Age Home Visit titled **"Sharing One, Caring All"** is to foster a sense of empathy, social responsibility, and compassion among students by sensitizing them to the needs, experiences, and emotional well-being of elderly residents. The visit aims to encourage meaningful interaction, promote respect for senior citizens, and help students understand the importance of care, inclusion, and community support for the aged, while nurturing values of service, solidarity, and humane engagement beyond the classroom.

DETAILS:

The Department of English from the School of Humanities organized an event on visiting Old Age Home (Sharing One Caring All), a visit to an old age home as part of our community service and social awareness program. The visit was arranged to help students understand the importance of caring for the elderly and to give an opportunity to interact with senior citizens. It was both an educational and emotional experience for everyone involved.

An old age home is a residential facility where elderly people live when they are unable to stay with their families or need special care and support. These homes provide shelter, food, medical assistance, and emotional companionship to senior citizens. We reached the old age home in the morning and were warmly welcomed by the staff members. They introduced to the residents and informed about their daily routine and need. The students interacted with the elderly people and listened to their life experiences, which were very inspiring and touching.

The students presented songs, poem and played games to entertain the residents. They also distributed food packets, mufflers and other useful items that they had collected earlier. The residents were very happy and enjoyed being with us.

During the visit, they learned the values of kindness, patience and compassion. The students realized that many elderly people need love and emotional support more than anything else. The visit helped us become more responsible and sensitive human being.

This visit to the old age home for the students of Humanities was educational and heart touching. It taught them importance of caring for the elderly and being helpful to society.

OUTCOME:
