OBJECTIVE: One type of experiential learning is role-playing. Some students play out a scene from the class to ensure they comprehend what they have learnt and to aid in their memory. Students performed a prepared play in which they were assigned roles. Students who might not be particularly interested in the subject are also encouraged by this.

DETAILS: It is still essential for the instructor to be an impartial role model for every student's academic development, regardless of whether a student is at the slower or advanced end of the range. A wide variety of pupils cohabit in Indian classrooms, including slower learners who need extra help both within and outside of the classroom, ordinary learners who frequently depend on teachers, and advanced learners who succeed. The faculty must create and modify various teaching strategies to make the class engaging in order for this action to be successful. Both slow and advanced learners gain from role-playing exercises. On **April 6th to 8th, 2026**, the School of Pharmacy held a session titled **"Role play on role of enzymes, importance of enzyme inhibitors in design of new drugs, therapeutic and diagnostic application of enzymes."** With a succinct summary of **"Role of enzymes, importance of enzyme inhibitors in design of new drugs, therapeutic and diagnostic application of enzymes."** this lesson was intended to capture the interest of both slower and more advanced learners. The B. PHARM (2nd Sem) students were instructed to play various roles in the function of enzymes, the significance of enzyme inhibitors in the development of novel medications, and the therapeutic and diagnostic use of enzymes in accordance with their preferences. Students played a variety of roles. The students eagerly participated, and the session was quite interesting. The session was conceptualized by Mr. Santanu Manna and guided by Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo sir and supported by Mr. Souradeep Dev and Mr Samiran Paul.

OUTCOMES: While advanced learners saw the session as a useful chance for review, slow learners' interest in a subject they had previously demonstrated little excitement for was piqued. These kinds of stimulating events should be regularly planned to support students' continued growth.

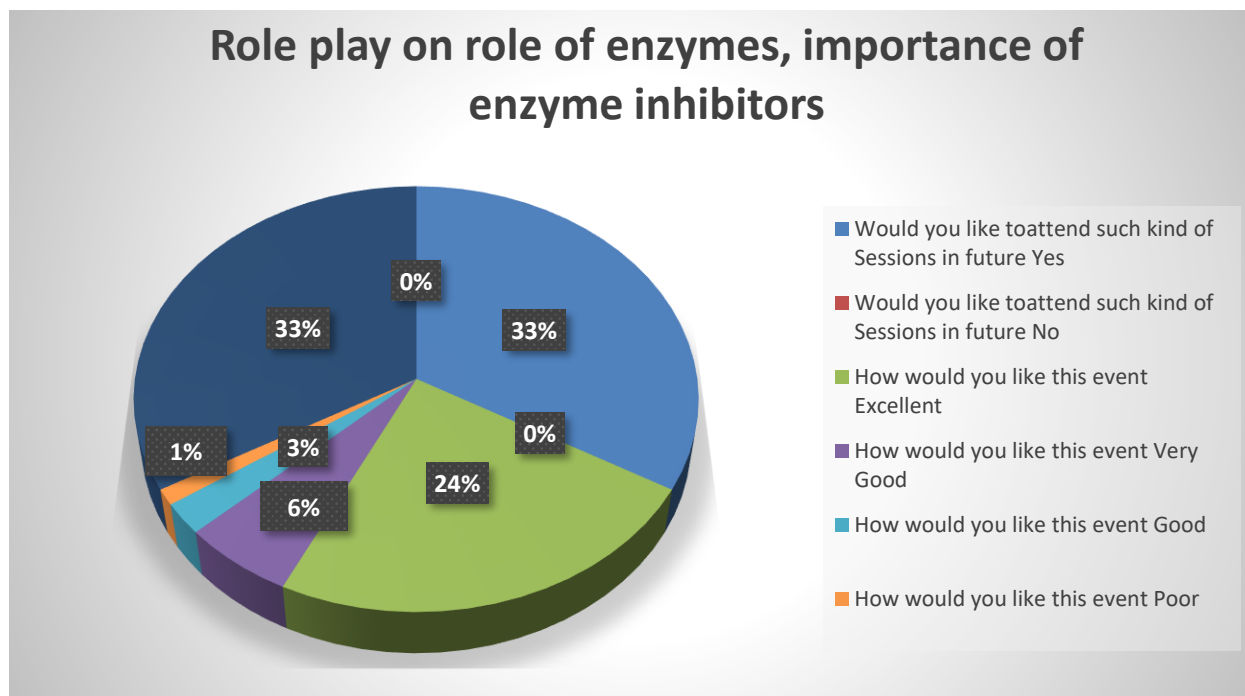
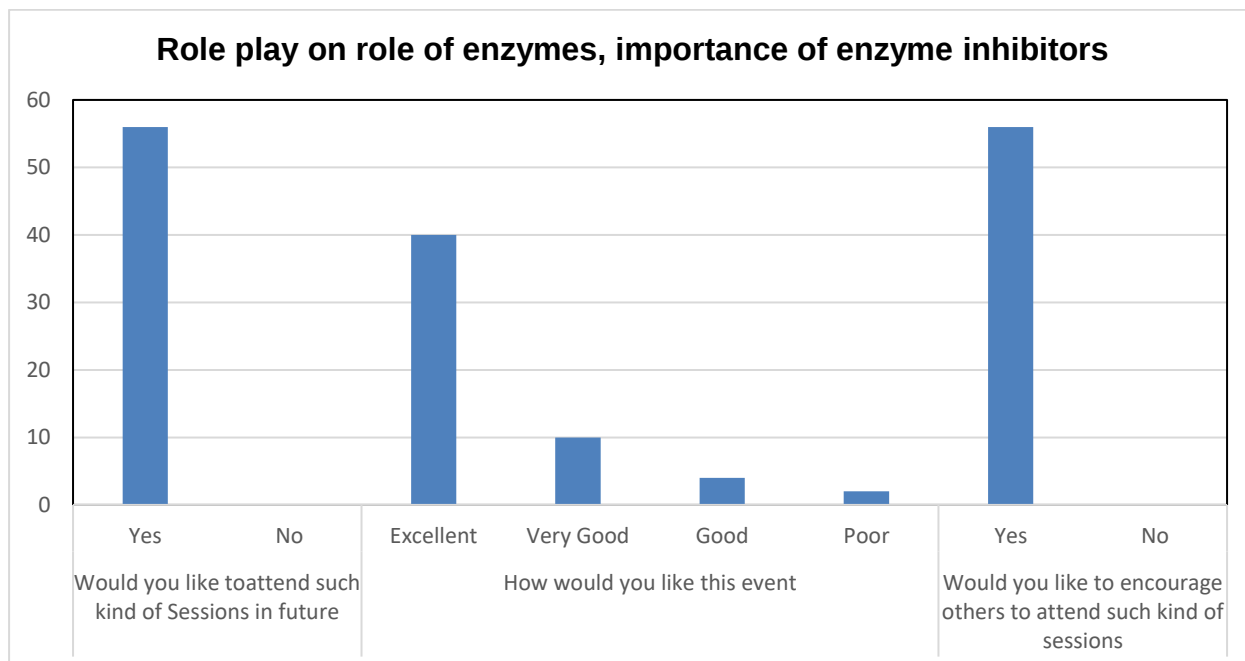


Fig. 4- Group photo for all the actors and responsible subject teachers for the event
