OBJECTIVE:

To enhance knowledge and academic skills in Forensic Nursing through role plays on a young woman's death due to dowry and domestic violence, and a real child abuse case presentation for Vth Semester B.Sc. Nursing students, fostering active participation, critical thinking, and application of medico-legal principles, while strengthening understanding of gender-based violence, child protection laws, and professional competencies in handling sensitive legal cases

DETAILS: The School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University, organized a Role Play Presentation on Forensic Case Scenarios focusing on Young Married Woman Death (Dowry & Domestic Violence) and Child Abuse, in Block A, Aryabhatta, Room No. 131, from 2:30 PM to 3:30 PM. The programme was coordinated by Prof. Shilpa J., Vice Principal and Course In-charge of the subject Introduction to Forensic Nursing and Indian Laws. The role play was conducted in a Simulation-based participatory learning format, highlighting critical aspects of forensic nursing such as medico-legal responsibilities, evidence preservation, documentation, ethical considerations, gender-based violence, and child protection laws. Through realistic enactment of case scenarios, students demonstrated their understanding of forensic principles, legal procedures, and the professional role of nurses in handling sensitive medico-legal situations. 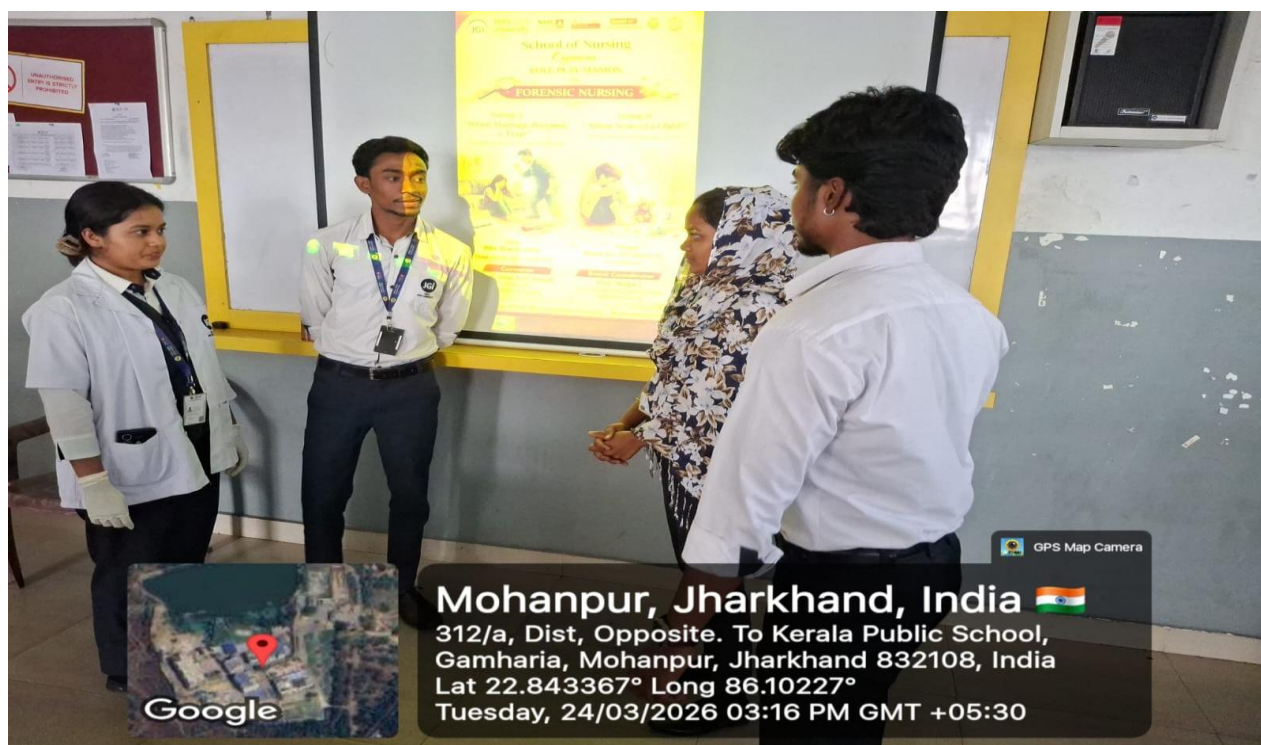


Fig 1: - Students actively participated in the Role Play Activity on the case scenario of Child Abuse.

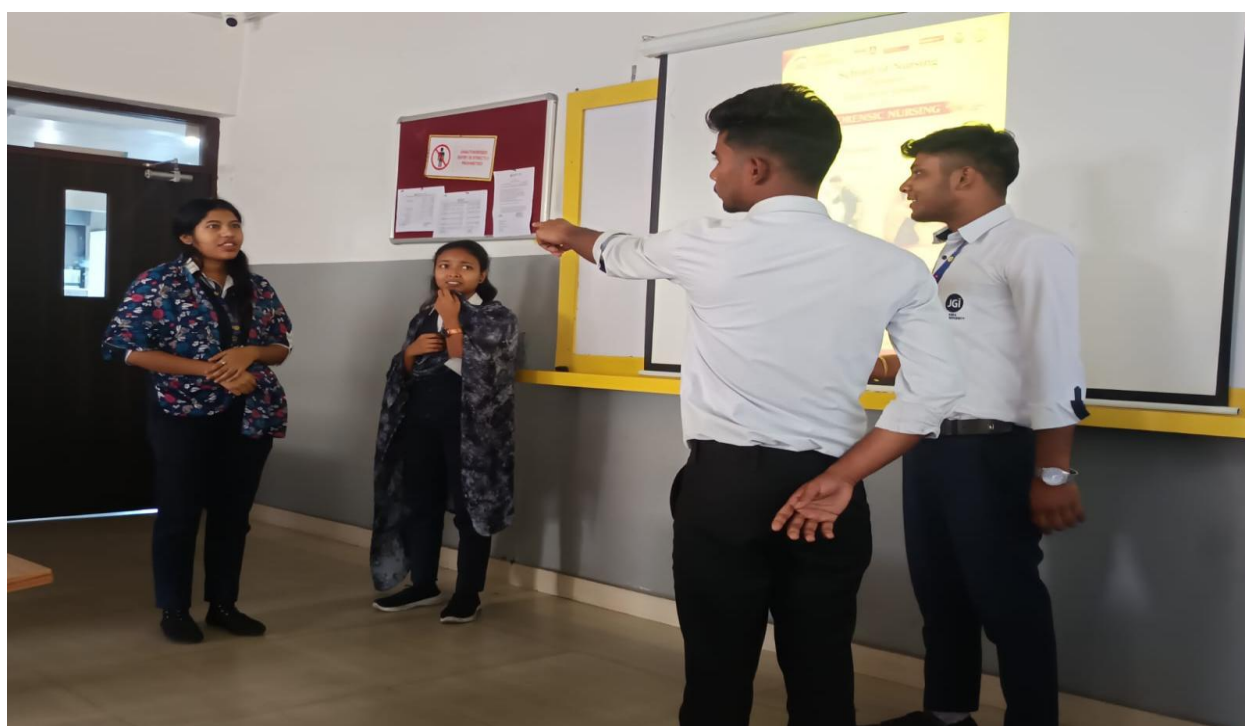


Fig 5: Students portraying an Investigative Team uncovering the truth and questioning the accused
